WHAT WAS THE PLAYOFF BOWL?

Following the 1961 and 1966 seasons, the Eagles participated in the Playoff Bowl. If case you never heard of the Playoff Bowl, here's the scoop. From 1960-1969, the National Football League took each conference's runner-up and matched them up in a consolation game at the Orange Bowl in Miami. The Eagles, by the way, lost both of their Playoff Bowl appearances (38-10 to Detroit in 1962 and 20-14 to Baltimore in 1967).
