

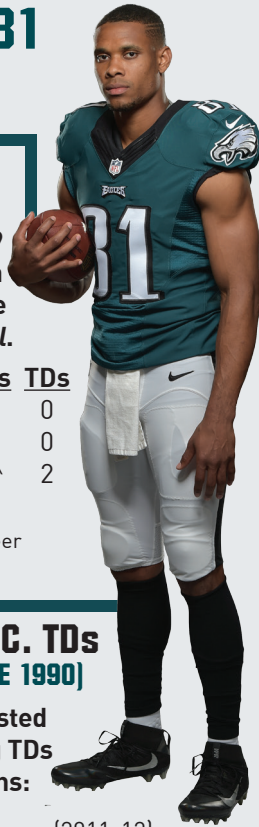

MONDAY NIGHT LIGHTS LAST THREE GAMES ON MNF

Matthews has combined for 299 yards (99.7 ypg) and two TDs on 23 receptions over his last three games on *Monday Night Football*.

800+ REC. YARDS, 8+ REC. TDs FIRST TWO NFL SEASONS (SINCE 1990)

Since 1990, only five players have posted 800+ receiving yards and 8+ receiving TDs in each of their first two NFL seasons:

- **Jordan Matthews (2014-15)**
- Julio Jones (2011-12)
- Odell Beckham (2014-15)
- Marques Colston (2006-07)
- Randy Moss (1998-99)

MORE ON MATTHEWS

- Matthews has recorded **50+ receiving yards** and **1+ receiving TDs** in four straight games, the **longest active streak in the NFL** and the **longest by an Eagles player** since **Terrell Owens** (four games) in 2004. Impressively, Matthews has posted three 100+ yard performances over that four-game span.

- Matthews' streak of **four consecutive games with a receiving TD** is tied with KC's **Jeremy Maclin** for the **second-longest active streak** in the NFL, trailing only NYJ's **Eric Decker** (six games).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- **Doug Pederson** is aiming to become the **first Eagles head coach in the Super Bowl Era** to win his first two games with the team. The last Philadelphia head coach to accomplish the feat was **Nick Skorich** in 1961.
- With a victory on Monday night, **Carson Wentz** will join **Mark Sanchez** (2009, NYJ), **Joe Flacco** (2008, Bal.), **Ryan Leaf** (1998, SD) and **John Elway** (1983, Den.) as the **only rookie QBs to win the first two games of the season** since the 1970 NFL merger.
- **Brent Celek's** 4,724 **career receiving yards** rank **10th** in franchise history. Celek is 40 yards shy of **Ben Hawkins** (4,764, 1966-73) for **ninth** and 47 yards shy of **Jeremy Maclin** (4,771, 2009-14) for **eighth** on the all-time list.
- Celek needs **one reception** to tie **Pete Pihos** (373, 1947-55) for the **fourth-most** catches in franchise history.
- **Darren Sproles** is one **punt return TD** away from claiming sole possession of first place on the Eagles' all-time list (four, currently tied with **DeSean Jackson**).
- **Connor Barwin** (27.5, 2013-present) is two **sacks** away from tying **Jerome Brown** (29.5, 1987-91) for the **15th-most** QB takedowns in Eagles history.
- **Jordan Matthews** is 17 **receiving yards** (1,983) shy of **2,000** for his **NFL career**.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 54** The Eagles scored the **sixth-most points** in **single-game franchise history** the last time they faced the Bears (W, 54-11 on 12/22/13).
- 101.0** In Week 1, **Carson Wentz** posted the **second-highest passer rating** (101.1) by an **Eagles rookie** since at least 1960 (min. 20 attempts).
- 29** Since 2001, the Eagles have appeared in 29 games (.621) on *Monday Night Football*, the **most by any NFL team** in that span.
- 5.0** **Fletcher Cox** has totaled **five sacks** in his last **five games** dating back to 2015. Cox has at least **one sack** in **four of those five games**.
- .613** The Eagles have produced a 78-49-1 (.613) record in **away games** since 2000, the **NFL's second-best winning percentage** in that span.
