Jason Miller was named the senior vice president of operations in 2014 after spending 11 years building and developing the team's facility operations department. In this role, Miller oversees all of the facility and event operations of Lincoln Financial Field, the NovaCare Complex and Aramark Suites and Concessions.

Miller joined the organization as the facilities manager with the opening of Lincoln Financial Field in 2003.
