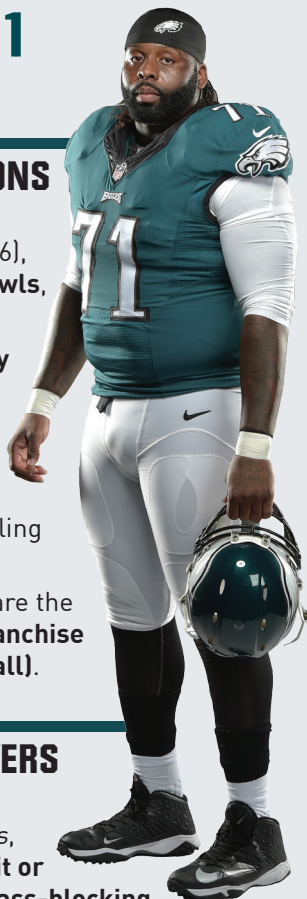

### MOST PRO BOWL SELECTIONS NFL OFFENSIVE LINEMEN

Over his 13-year NFL career (2004-16), Peters has been selected to 8 Pro Bowls, including 6 with the Eagles.

- Peters' 8 Pro Bowls are the most by an undrafted offensive lineman since the 1970 NFL merger.
- Since Peters entered the league in 2004, his 8 Pro Bowls rank 2nd among NFL offensive linemen, trailing only Joe Thomas (9) in that span.
- His 6 Pro Bowls with Philadelphia are the most by an offensive lineman in franchise history (tied for the 4th-most overall).



### TOP-GRADED NFL PLAYERS PRO FOOTBALL FOCUS

According to *Pro Football Focus*, Peters did not allow a single hit or hurry on Carson Wentz in 41 pass-blocking snaps in Week 10 vs. Atlanta (W, 24-15). Peters was graded as the Eagles' top offensive player (84.8) in the win against the Falcons.

### BIRDS' NEST

- Carson Wentz is the only player in Eagles history to throw for 2,000+ yards while completing 65.0% of his passes in the first nine games of the season.
- Wentz ranks 3rd in the NFL with a 131.9 third-quarter passer rating in 2016, trailing only Tom Brady (150.5) and Matt Ryan (145.8).
- Ryan Mathews is just the fifth Eagle since 1950 to record 7+ rushing TDs in the first nine games of the season, joining LeSean McCoy (10 in 2011), Ricky Watters (8 in 1996), Wilbert Montgomery (7 in 1982) and Billy Ray Barnes (7 in 1958).
- According to *Pro Football Focus*, Brandon Graham is tied with Khalil Mack as the highest-graded edge defenders (90.3) in the NFL in 2016.
- Only three NFL players have posted 8+ INTs and 8+ FFs since 2013: Rodney McLeod (8 INTs, 8 FFs), Thomas Davis (8 INTs, 8 FFs) and Lavonte David (8 INTs, 10 FFs). McLeod is the only DB to accomplish the feat in that span.

### WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- Darren Sproles (29 receiving, 20 rushing from 2005-16) is 1 receiving TD shy of becoming the eighth player in NFL history with 30+ career receiving TDs and 20+ career rushing TDs (first since Brian Westbrook, 2002-10).
- Sproles is also just 2 yards shy of his ninth consecutive season with 300+ receiving yards, the longest streak by an NFL RB since Tiki Barber (also nine seasons, 2002-10).
- Jordan Matthews needs 1 receiving TD to have 20 for his NFL career (42 games). Matthews would become the 3rd-fastest Eagle to reach that milestone, trailing only Mike Quick (34 games) and Ben Hawkins (40 games).
- Connor Barwin is 0.5 sacks shy of 50 for his NFL career. Barwin has posted sacks in three of his last four games.

### BY THE NUMBERS

-267

The Eagles lead the NFL in opponent yards lost on negative plays (-267) in 2016, while ranking 5th in opponent negative plays (65).

81.1

Philadelphia has held opposing QBs to the 5th-lowest passer rating (81.1) in the NFL this season (Russell Wilson - 99.4).

70.4%

The Eagles lead the NFL in opponent red zone scoring efficiency (70.4%, 19-of-27) in 2016, while Seattle (78.6%, 22-of-28) ranks 3rd.

47.4%

Philadelphia leads the NFC and ranks 4th in the NFL in percentage of rushes gaining 4+ yards (47.4%, 119-of-251) this season.

32:28

The Eagles rank 2nd in the NFL in time of possession (32:28) in 2016 (1st in second-half TOP, 17:44), trailing only Dallas (33:13).

20+

Philadelphia has registered 20+ points in 11 straight games (including seven road games), marking the longest active streak in the NFL.

17.8

The Eagles rank 3rd in the NFL in points allowed per game (17.8) this season, trailing only Minnesota (16.9) and Seattle (17.6).
