### GOING THE DISTANCE

- In 2016, Sturgis has gone **18-of-18 on attempts under 40 yards** and 7-of-11 (63.6%) on attempts above 40 yards, including **4-of-5 (80.0%) from 50+ yards**.
- Sturgis' **4 FGs of 50+ yards** are tied with **Cody Parkey** (2014) for the **most ever by an Eagles kicker in a single season**.
- Sturgis is **one of only four NFL kickers with four 50+ yard FGs in 2016**, joining **Justin Tucker** (7-of-7), **Adam Vinatieri** (5-of-6) and **Matt Prater** (4-of-4).

### CAREER YEAR

- Sturgis has been **successful on a career-high 86.2% (25-of-29) of his FG attempts in 2016**.
- On the road in 2016:** 14-of-15 (93.3%), 3-of-3 from 50+ yards.
- Sturgis **connected on a career-best 18 consecutive FGs from Week 1-9**, marking the **2nd-longest streak in Eagles history** (22, **Alex Henery** in 2012).

# 98

**CAREER FIELD GOALS**  
Sturgis is 2 FGs shy of 100 for his NFL career.

# 96

**100-POINT SEASONS**  
Sturgis is on pace for the **4th-most points (140) in single-season team history** & is 4 points shy of his third career 100-point season (111 in 2013; 128 in 2014).

### WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- Jon Dorenbos** (2006-16) will appear in his **161st consecutive game with the Eagles**, marking the **2nd-longest streak in franchise history** (**Harold Carmichael**, 162 games from 1972-83).
- Dorenbos ranks **6th on the Eagles' all-time list for games played**, trailing only **David Akers** (188, 1999-2010), **Brian Dawkins** (183, 1996-2008), **Harold Carmichael** (180, 1971-83), **Chuck Bednarik** (169, 1949-62) and **Tra Thomas** (166, 1998-2008).
- Darren Sproles** (29 receiving, 20 rushing from 2005-16) is **1 receiving TD shy of becoming the eighth player in NFL history with 30+ receiving TDs and 20+ rushing TDs** (first since **Brian Westbrook**, 2002-10).
- Jordan Matthews** (19) needs **1 receiving TD to have 20 for his NFL career (44 games)**. Matthews would become the **3rd-fastest Eagle to reach that milestone**, trailing only **Mike Quick** (34 games) and **Ben Hawkins** (40 games).
- Connor Barwin** (49.5) is a **half sack shy of 50 quarterback takedowns for his NFL career**.

### BY THE NUMBERS

# 213

The last time Philadelphia allowed **213-or-fewer points in the first 11 games of the season** was in 2004 (164 points).

# 114.9

The Eagles rank **8th in the NFL in rushing yards per game (114.9)** in 2016, trailing only Dallas (157.3) and San Francisco (126.5) in the NFC.

# 76.5%

Philadelphia has registered the **NFL's best opponent red zone scoring efficiency (76.5%, 26-of-34)** this season.

# .650

Since 2008, the Eagles have produced a **6-3-1 (.650) record against AFC North opponents**, including a **2-0 mark in 2016**.

# 31.2

Philadelphia **leads the NFL in kickoff return average (31.2)** this season and is the **only team to record multiple kickoff return TDs**.

# 9-1

The Eagles have gone **9-1 (.900) vs. the AFC** since 2014, marking the **best interconference winning percentage in the NFL** in that span.

# 1.71

Philadelphia ranks **1st in the NFL in opponent yards per play inside the red zone (1.71)**, allowing just 142 yards on 83 plays.
