- The Eagles lead the NFL in kickoff return average (30.6) in 2016. Philadelphia's 30.6 kickoff return average is more than 3.0 yards greater than the club's single-season record set in 2014 (27.3).
- Kenjon Barner (31.4) and Wendell Smallwood (29.3) rank 3rd and 6th in the NFL, respectively, in kickoff return average this season (min. 8 kickoff returns).
- The Eagles are the only NFL team with multiple kickoff return TDs in 2016. Smallwood had an 86-yard kickoff return TD in Week 6 vs. Washington.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- Jon Dorenbos (2006-16) will appear in his 162nd consecutive game with the Eagles, which is tied with Harold Carmichael (1972-83) for the longest streak in franchise history.
- Dorenbos ranks 6th on the Eagles' all-time games played list, trailing only David Akers (188, 1999-2010), Brian Dawkins (183, 1996-2008), Harold Carmichael (180, 1971-83), Chuck Bednarik (169, 1949-62) and Tra Thomas (166, 1998-2008).
- Darren Sproles (29 receiving, 21 rushing from 2005-16) is 1 receiving TD shy of becoming the eighth player in NFL history with 30+ receiving TDs and 20+ rushing TDs (first since Brian Westbrook, 2002-10).
- Sproles is 1 punt return TD away from claiming sole possession of first place on the Eagles' all-time list (4, currently tied with DeSean Jackson).
- Connor Barwin (49.5) is a half sack shy of 50 quarterback takedowns for his NFL career.
- Caleb Sturgis (98) is 2 FGs shy of 100 for his NFL career. Sturgis (98) is also 2 points shy of the third 100-point season of his career (111 in 2013; 128 in 2014).

BY THE NUMBERS

109.8

The Eagles rank 4th in the NFC in rushing offense (109.8), trailing only Dallas (155.8), San Francisco (127.7) and Atlanta (110.0).

82

Philadelphia is tied for the 5th-most opponent negative plays (82) in the NFL, as well as 5th in opponent yards lost on negative plays (-307).

60.0

Leaders in combined sacks, knockdowns and hurries in 2016: Von Miller (67.5), Brandon Graham (60.0) and Aaron Donald (59.0).

+56

The Eagles are outscoring opponents 121-65 (+56) through five home games in 2016 (only 6 TDs allowed at Lincoln Financial Field).

31:48

The Eagles rank 2nd in the NFL in time of possession (31:48) (lead the NFL in second-half TOP, 16:46), trailing only Dallas (32:20).

6+

Since 2010, only three NFL RBs have had five seasons with 6+ rushing TDs: Ryan Mathews, Adrian Peterson and Marshawn Lynch.

3.0

The Eagles have held teams to 3.0-or-fewer yards per rush attempt in two straight games (2.6 in Week 12 vs. G.B.; 2.4 in Week 13 at Cin.).
