300+ YARDS & 30+ COMPLETIONS CONSECUTIVE GAMES

Carson Wentz is the only rookie in NFL history to post 300+ yards and 30+ completions in back-to-back games (Dec. 4-11, 2016). Wentz joins Sam Bradford (Dec. 26, 2015-Jan. 3, 2016) and Donovan McNabb (Sept. 25-Oct. 2, 2005) as the only QBs in franchise history to accomplish the feat.

NOTES TO KNOW

- Since Week 9, Zach Ertz leads all NFL TEs in receptions (42) and ranks 2nd in receiving yards (414), trailing only Travis Kelce (539). In his last two games, Ertz has combined for 191 yards and 1 TD on 19 receptions.
- Only five players in NFL history have recorded 65+ receptions, 750+ receiving yards and 3+ receiving TDs in each of their first three seasons: Randy Moss (1998-2000), A.J. Green (2011-13), Odell Beckham (2014-16), Mike Evans (2014-16) and Jordan Matthews (2014-16).
- Since 2010, only three NFL RBs have had five seasons with 6+ rushing TDs: Ryan Mathews, Adrian Peterson and Marshawn Lynch. Mathews has posted a career-high-tying 7 rushing TDs in 2016 (also 7 TDs in 2010).
- Brandon Graham (61) is tied with Olivier Vernon for the 3rd-most combined sacks, hits and hurries in the NFL this season, trailing only Von Miller (69) and Aaron Donald (63) in that category.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- Carson Wentz's 3,215 passing yards are the 5th-most by any Eagles QB through the first 13 games of the season, trailing only Donovan McNabb in 2004 (3,616), Sonny Jurgensen in 1961 (3,320), Randall Cunningham in 1988 (3,236) and McNabb in 2008 (3,221).
- Wentz (317) is 30 completions shy of the Eagles single-season record. Only Sam Bradford in 2015 (346) and Donovan McNabb in 2008 (345) and 2000 (330) have completed more passes in a single season for the team.

BY THE NUMBERS

50+

Caleb Sturgis is tied with Cody Parkey in 2014 for the most 50+ yard FGs (4) in Eagles single-season history.

32:10

Philadelphia ranks 1st in time of possession (32:10) this season, including a league-leading 16:53 mark in the second half of games.

30

The Eagles are tied with Dallas for the 2nd-most 10-play drives (30) in the NFL this season, trailing only Detroit (32).

27

The Eagles currently rank 3rd in the NFL in 5-minute drives (27) in 2016, trailing only Dallas (30) and Detroit (29).

15.0%

Philadelphia leads the NFL in opponent red zone third-down percentage (15.0%), allowing just 3 conversions in 20 attempts.

9-2

Since 2014, the Eagles have gone 9-2 vs. AFC teams, marking the NFL's best interconference winning percentage (.818) in that span.

4

Philadelphia is tied for the 4th-most non-offensive TDs (4) in the NFL in 2016, trailing only Kansas City (7), Minnesota (6) and Atlanta (5).
