Originally a fifth-round draft choice of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 2013, Steven Means was signed by the Eagles off of the Texans practice squad following Week 13 of the 2015 season. Means appeared in 11 games over his first two seasons with Tampa Bay, recording five tackles, in addition to contributing on special teams. A native of Buffalo, NY, Means was a four-year letterman at the University at Buffalo, where he finished his career ranked fourth in school history with 18.5 sacks.

BIRDSEED

- According to Means, the best player he has ever lined up against is current teammate and Eagles LT Jason Peters. In fact, Peters was part of his "welcome to the NFL" moment. As a rookie for the Buccaneers in 2013, Means' performance in a Week 4 matchup against the Cardinals led to increased snaps the following game. It just so happened that the next contest would be against the Eagles and o-line anchor, Peters. Said Means, "I just remember this one play where Jason literally lifted me up in the air and slammed me to the ground. It didn't stop there. He rested his hands on my chest and made sure that my back remained on the grass until the play was over. I was in total shock at the time and just kept thinking that you have to come ready to play on every single down at this level."

2016 HIGHLIGHTS

- Blocked his first-career punt with under two minutes remaining vs. Dal. (1/1). It was recovered by the Eagles inside the 10-yard line and led to a rushing TD three plays later
- Logged his first-career sack and forced fumble in a win vs. Min. (10/24)

PERSONAL

- Most memorable college moment took place in a game against Miami (OH) when he found out that an NFL rep was in attendance to scout him. It was the first time that he realized his NFL dream could come to fruition
- Enjoyed watching some of the game's elite pass rushers including Bruce Smith, Michael Strahan and Lawrence Taylor. Growing up, was a huge fan of his hometown team the Buffalo Bills and QB Doug Flutie
- Currently follows the careers of JJ Watt, Pernell McPhee, Elvis Dumervil, Cliff Avril and college teammate Kahlil Mack
- If he could be one superhero, it would be The Incredible Hulk
- Favorite musical artists include Lil Wayne, T-Pain and Meek Mill
- Was an active member in the Tampa Bay community during his two years as a Buccaneer, participating in several team initiatives, including visiting patients at St. Joseph's Children's Hospital and All Children's Hospital, working with local YMCAs and visiting local servicemen and servicewomen at MacDill Air Force Base

- A two-time All-Western New York selection at Grover Cleveland High School, notched 108 tackles, 20 sacks, five forced fumbles and one interception as a senior in 2007, leading his team to an appearance in the Western New York Harvard Cup
- Son of Steven, Sr. and Gwen Means. Has two younger brothers, Brandon and Cameron
- Earned his degree in sociology

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 48 games (42 starts) at Buffalo, posting 185 tackles, 29.5 tackles for loss, 18.5 sacks, three forced fumbles, three fumble recoveries and two interceptions, while also blocking five kicks
- Finished his career ranked fourth in Buffalo annals in sacks with 18.5 and tied for 10th in tackles for loss with 29.5
- As a senior in 2012, earned All-MAC second-team honors after posting career highs in tackles (77), tackles for loss (11) and sacks (6.5)

- Notched 33 tackles and 2.5 sacks as a junior in 2011. Also returned an interception for a touchdown
- Collared 50 tackles, a team-leading 4.5 sacks and two forced fumbles as a redshirt sophomore in 2010
- Led the Bulls in sacks (five) as a redshirt freshman in 2009, earning first-team All-Freshman honors from *Phil Steele*
- Redshirted in 2008
