Kamu Grugier-Hill (pronounced KAH-moo GREW-jay HILL) was acquired by the Eagles off waivers from the New England Patriots on Sept. 4, 2016, following the 53-man roster cutdown. Originally a sixth-round draft choice of the Patriots in 2016, Grugier-Hill played in 49 games over his four-year career at Eastern Illinois and earned first-team Ohio Valley Conference accolades as a junior and senior. As a senior in 2015, he compiled 70 tackles (16.5 for a loss) and 6.5 sacks.

BIRDSEED

- Pre-game ritual consists of listening to country music until an hour and a half before kickoff and then listening to rap until warmups. Following warmups, he switches to EDM/house music until the team walks out of the tunnel for kickoff
- Became the 15th player in Eastern Illinois history to be selected in the NFL Draft and the first since QB Jimmy Garoppolo was picked by the New England Patriots in 2014. Also became just the third Panthers defender and the first Panthers LB to be drafted by an NFL club

2016 HIGHLIGHTS

- Notched a special teams tackle at Bal. (12/18) and vs. Dal. (1/1)
- Returned to action in Week 11 at Sea. (11/20) and notched his third special teams tackle of the season
- Tallied a special teams tackles at Was. (10/16)
- Recorded the first special teams tackles of his career in a win vs. Pit. (9/25)
- Made his first career tackle in the NFL when he dropped Browns RB Duke Johnson Jr. for a 6-yard loss on a fake punt vs. Cle. (9/11)

INJURY REPORT

- Rendered inactive in Week 8 at Dal (10/30), Week 9 at NYG (11/6) and Week 10 vs. Atl. (11/13) due to a hamstring injury suffered vs. Min. (10/23)
- Sustained a hamstring injury in the second quarter vs. Min. (10/23) and did not return to the game

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Played in 49 games (27 starts) for the Eastern Illinois Panthers and finished his career with 236 tackles (136 solo), nine sacks, six interceptions, nine passes defended, four forced fumbles and five fumble recoveries
- Made 10 starts as a senior in 2015 and was named first-team Ohio Valley Conference after compiling 70 tackles (50 solo) and a career-high 6.5 sacks. Also registered an interception and set a single-season career-high with three fumble recoveries
- Appeared in 12 games (11 starts) as a junior in 2014 and garnered first-team OVC accolades after leading the team with a career-high 97 tackles (47 solo). Also notched 1.5 sacks, two FFs, two FRs recoveries and three INTs. Was named the OVC Defensive Player of the Week after he compiled 19 tackles in a win at Tennessee Tech (11/1/14)
- Saw action in all 14 games as a sophomore in 2013 and made five starts. Compiled 42 tackles (24 solo), the first sack of his career, an interception, three passes defended and a forced fumble
