Originally a fifth-round draft choice of the Miami Dolphins in 2013, Caleb Sturgis was signed by the Eagles following Week 3 of the 2015 regular season and has developed into one of the top kickers in the NFL while setting the Eagles record for most field goals in a season with 35. A four-year letterman at the University of Florida, Sturgis was a two-time finalist for the coveted Lou Groza Award (2011, '12).

**2016 HIGHLIGHTS**

- Set an Eagles record with 35 field goals this season, which also tied for the second-highest total in the NFL. His 135 points ranked fourth in the NFL and were the fifth-highest total ever by an Eagle
- Made four 50-plus yard field goals this season, tying Cody Parkey (four in 2014) for the team record in that category
- Connected on 18 consecutive field goal attempts which is a career high the second-longest streak in team history
- Despite heavy winds, tied a career high after making all four attempts at Bal. (12/18)
- Made both of his field goal attempts vs. GB (11/28), including his fourth 50-yarder of the season and a 48 yarder
- Went 3-3 at Dal. (10/30), including a career-long 55-yarder that ranks as the third-longest in Eagles history
- Nailed all three of his field goal attempts at Det. (10/9), including his 10th-career 50-plus yarder, and his fourth as an Eagle
- Connected on all three of his attempts, including a 53-yarder at Chi. (9/19), tying for the second-longest field goal of his career and the fifth-longest in team history

**BIRDSEED**

- Grew up in a family with six children (two girls, four boys), who were all homeschooled by his mom, Karen. His dad, Smiley, is a pastor at Good News Church in St. Augustine
- Caleb's brother, Nathan, is a professional soccer player who currently plays for the Seattle Sounders
- Growing up in St. Augustine, FL, Sturgis was a big fan of the Jacksonville Jaguars as a kid and even went to their training camp practices when he was eight years old. His first jerseys were Mark Brunell and Natrone Means
- Always seems to enjoy his most successful games in his home state of Florida. As a sophomore in high school, he hit a 49-yarder in Sun Life Stadium. He later hit a career-long 56 yarder as a sophomore at Florida against Georgia at EverBank Field. Two of his 50-plus yarders in the NFL have come in the state of Florida as well

- Sturgis met his wife, Kimberly, at the University of Florida, where she was a cheerleader. She is currently a fitness instructor in Gainesville, FL
- Attended St. Augustine (FL) High School where he earned first-team Class 3A All-State honors as a senior placekicker

## PERSONAL (Continued)

- Did not start playing football until his sophomore year in high school when his high school coach approached him about it. He went on to hit a 49-yard field goal that year in Sun Life Stadium, which is when he realized he had a potential future as a kicker
- Also competed as a forward on St. Augustine's soccer team and for the Julington Creek club
- Says the biggest influence on his career has been his older brother, Nathan. "It's been great to be able to learn from somebody who is also playing a professional sport"
- Enjoys golf and other leisure sports. "Whether it's golf or cornhole, I'm very competitive"
- During the offseason, Sturgis spends some of his free time helping his dad, who is a pastor at Good News Church and works to start other churches around the country

## 2015 HIGHLIGHTS

- Recorded his 11th-career game with three or more field goals after making all three of his attempts vs. Buf. (12/13)
- Booted two field goals in a win at Dal. (11/8), including a 53-yarder which tied the second-longest kick of his career. He became just the second Eagle ever with a 50-plus yard field goal in back-to-back games and the first since Tom Dempsey in 1971. His go-ahead 53-yarder late in the fourth quarter tied for the fifth-longest in team history
- Converted 3-of-4 field goals at Car. (10/25), including a 52-yarder which marked his seventh 50-plus-yard field goal of his career and tied for the eighth longest kick in team history
- Connected on all four of his field goal attempts vs. NO (10/11) to tie a career high. Became the 12th Eagles kicker to have four field goals in a game, but just the second to do so by his second game with the team (Paul McFadden in 1984)



### 2014 HIGHLIGHTS (WITH MIAMI)

- Finished second in Dolphins single-season history with 128 points, while connecting on 29-of-37 field goals (78.4%) and 41-of-41 extra point attempts
- Booted a game-winning 26-yard field goal with 1:57 left in the fourth quarter at NYJ (12/1), the first game-winning kick in the fourth quarter or overtime of his career
- Made 3-of-3 field goals at Det. (11/9), including a 50-yarder
- Hit a 51-yard field goal vs. KC (9/21)
- Connected on a career-high 4-of-4 field goals vs. NE (9/7)

### 2013 HIGHLIGHTS (WITH MIAMI)

- As a rookie, led the Dolphins in scoring with 111 points and earned *Pro Football Weekly*/Pro Football Writers of America All-Rookie Team honors after connecting on 26-of-34 field goals and all 33 extra point attempts
- Hit three field goals of 50-plus yards, including a 54 yarder at Ind. (9/15/13), becoming the only Dolphins rookie to connect on three 50-yard field goals in team history
- Kicked a 44-yard field goal to tie the game with 16 seconds remaining in regulation vs. Cin. (10/31). The Dolphins went on to win the game, 22-20, in overtime
- Booted field goals of 46 and 50 yards vs. Atl. (9/22), becoming just the second rookie kicker in team history to connect on two field goals of 50-plus yards
- Connected on a 54-yard field goal at Ind. (9/15), which tied for the fourth-longest regular-season field goal in Dolphins history and the second-longest kick by a Dolphins rookie
- Made his NFL debut at Cle. (9/8) and scored 11 points, going 3-for-3 on field goals, which tied for the second-most field goals in a game by a Dolphins rookie behind Dan Carpenter (four - 11/2/08 at Den.)

### COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- A four-year letterman at Florida, connected on 70-of-88 career field goal attempts (79.5%) and finished his career with 340 points
- Set Florida career records in both made field goals (70) and field goal attempts (88)
- Was a three-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll
- As a redshirt senior in 2012, set a school single-season record with 24 field goals on 28 attempts and was named the SEC co-Special Teams Player of the Year and a finalist for the Lou Groza Award, which is given annually to the nation's top placekicker
- Hit 3-of-3 field goals of 50-plus yards as a senior
- As a redshirt junior in 2011, was a first-team All-American and All-SEC selection and a finalist for the Lou Groza Award after making 22-of-26 field goals with a long of 55 yards, the third-longest make in the country that season. Also finished third in the country with 22 made field goals in 2011
- Appeared in four games as a junior in 2010 before suffering a back injury that sidelined him for the final nine games of the season. Earned a medical redshirt due to the injury
- Played in 14 games as a sophomore in 2009, hitting 22-of-30 field goals including a career-long 56 yarder vs. Georgia (10/31/09), the SEC's longest made field goal of the year
- Handled kickoff duties as a true freshman in 2008
