- Was a disruptive force throughout a 21-10 win vs. Min. (10/23/16), recording 3 tackles (2 solo), a career-high 6 hurries and a strip-sack of Vikings QB **Sam Bradford**
- Registered a sack in three consecutive games to open the 2016 season (Browns QB **Robert Griffin III** on 9/11/16; Bears QB **Jay Cutler** on 9/19/16; Steelers QB **Ben Roethlisberger** on 9/25/16). Became the first Eagle to record a sack in each of the first three games of a season since **Jason Babin**, **Trent Cole** and **Cullen Jenkins** in 2011
- Finished the 2015 season tied for the team lead with 3 FFs and ranked 3rd with a career-high 6.5 sacks. Also set a career high with 63 tackles (44 solo)
- Posted his sixth-career multi-sack game after taking down Patriots QB **Tom Brady** twice at NE (12/6/15)
- Recorded 2 sacks against Cowboys QB **Matt Cassel** at Dal. (11/8/15), jarring the ball loose on both takedowns



BIGGEST INFLUENCE

Graham names his mother, Tasha Graham, as being the most influential person in his life. A cancer survivor, Tasha was diagnosed with leukemia at a young age. She spent most of her life working at a Chrysler auto plant to support Brandon and his three sisters.

Recalled Tasha, "The doctors told me I would never be able to have kids, so I cherish them because of that. When I was working at Chrysler, working hard, trying to make ends meet, it was for them and Brandon saw that."

THE SELECT 100

Graham organized a co-ed, high school football camp in Michigan called the Select 100 that takes 10 students (five boys and five girls) from each of Detroit's 20 public schools. The inaugural camp took place in summer 2015 and helps promote teamwork, confidence through sports and self esteem.

FUTURE PLANS

Graham is currently nine credits shy of obtaining a degree in sports management and plans to finish following his football career. He has also taken an interest in sports broadcasting and would like to attend the NFL's Broadcast Boot Camp.

HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

Graham was a four-year starter at Crockett Vocational Technical (Detroit, MI) and earned Parade, EA Sports and USA Today first-team All-America honors as a senior. That year, he was also named the Michigan Gatorade Player of the Year.

Graham recorded 307 tackles, including 112 TFL, 56 sacks, 16 FRs, 6 FFs and 2 INTs during his high school career. Additionally, Graham averaged more than 40 yards per attempt as a punter.

Outside of football, Graham lettered in basketball and track and field. Graham regularly donates uniforms and equipment to his high school alma mater.

- In 2014, ranked 3rd in the NFL with a career-high 4 FFs, trailing only **Ryan Kerrigan** (5) and **Robert Quinn** (5). Also produced the 2nd-most TFL (13.5) on the team

- Tallied 1.5 sacks vs. Car. (11/10/14), including a strip-sack of Panthers QB **Cam Newton**
- Sacked Saints QB **Drew Brees** in his first career playoff game in the NFC Wild Card game vs. NO (1/4/14)
- In just 13 defensive snaps, notched 2 sacks of Cardinals QB **Carson Palmer** vs. Ari. (12/1/13)

LEADING BY EXAMPLE

Rod Oden, who was an assistant coach at Crockett Vocational Technical (Detroit, MI) while Graham was in high school, is now the head coach there and fondly reflects on Graham's work ethic and the impact he has made on the program.

"He was an absolute leader," said Oden. "The entire school would follow Brandon. He's a leader in demonstration. We say, 'Leadership is demonstrated, it's not announced.' He walks in a room and his presence commands respect. People see him put in the extra hours. They see him run the extra sprints, lift the extra weights, and they follow. Now we have kids who want to be the next Brandon. They're still following."

BIRDSEED

Graham is the son of Tasha Graham and Derrick Walton and has three younger sisters: Brittany, Mikayla and Brianna. Graham married Carlyne Williams during the 2014 offseason and resides in Philadelphia. The couple gave birth to their first child, daughter Emerson, in the winter of 2016. They also have a cocker spaniel named Midnight.

Graham began playing football as a linebacker, center and running back for the Detroit Giants when he was 7 years old. His greatest love besides football growing up was doing flips in gymnastics. "I started doing it when I was young and I just got better and better. It's really fun. I can do about 10 in a row now."

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Played in 46 games (28 starts) at Michigan, recording 138 tackles (85 solo), 29.5 sacks, 56 TFL, 8 FFs and 3 FRs. Finished his college career ranked 2nd in school history in sacks (29.5), FFs (8) and TFL (56)
- Also blocked 2 punts and returned a teammate's blocked punt 2 yards for a TD vs. Delaware State (10/17/09). Marks the last time he reached the end zone
- Selected as Michigan's Bo Schembechler MVP twice (2008-09) in his career, becoming the first defensive player in school history to accomplish the feat. The previous two-time MVPs were RB **Mike Hart** (2006-07), WR **Anthony Carter** (1980, 1982), RB **Ron Johnson** (1968-69), RB **Tom Harmon** (1939-40) and G **Ralph Heikkinen** (1937-38)
- Was a second-team All-America selection and first-team All-Big Ten Conference pick as a senior in 2009. Also finished as a finalist for the Ted Hendricks Award, which is given annually to the nation's top college defensive end. Recorded a career-best 64 tackles (42 solo) and team-high 10.5 sacks, while lead the NCAA with 26 TFL (2nd-best single-season total in Michigan history)
