One of the toughest and most reliable players in team history, **Brent Celek** does it all from the TE position. Despite not being invited to the NFL Scouting Combine, Celek went on to become a 5th-round pick (162nd overall) in 2007 and developed into one of the most productive Eagles TEs ever. He has also ingrained himself within the community with his philanthropic work and business acumen. After inking a new deal in 2016, Celek is signed through 2018.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Has produced the 4th-most receptions (385) in franchise history, trailing only **Harold Carmichael** (589 from 1971-83), **Pete Retzlaff** (452 from 1956-66) and **Brian Westbrook** (426 from 2002-09)
- Ranks 8th in Eagles history with 4,868 receiving yards, behind **Harold Carmichael** (8,978 from 1971-83), **Pete Retzlaff** (7,412 from 1956-66), **Mike Quick** (6,464 from 1982-90), **DeSean Jackson** (6,117 from 2008-13), **Pete Pihos** (5,619 from 1947-55), **Tommy McDonald** (5,499 from 1957-63) and **Bobby Walston** (5,363 from 1951-62)



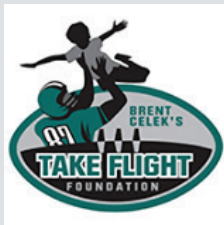
CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Posted 134 yards on 4 catches, including a 60-yard grab from **Sam Bradford** vs. Mia. (11/15/15). His 33.5 receiving average was the most by an NFL TE with 4+ catches since **M.L. Harris** (37.0 - 4 rec., 148 yards) at NYJ on 9/16/84
- Hauled in a 1-yard TD from **Nick Foles** vs. Ari. (12/1/13), moving past **Chad Lewis** (23 from 1997-2005) for the 2nd-most TDs ever by an Eagles TE, trailing only **Pete Retzlaff** (47 from 1956-66)
- Totaled 157 receiving yards at Bal. (9/16/12), which is the 2nd-most yards ever by a TE in single-game franchise history, behind **Pete Retzlaff's** 204-yard effort against the Redskins on 11/14/65
- In 2011, tied **Jeremy Maclin** for the team's most receiving TDs (5) while ranking 2nd in receptions (62) and 3rd in receiving yards (811). Celek (811), Maclin (859) and **DeSean Jackson** (961) became the first trio in Eagles history to each post 800+ receiving yards in the same season

- Set a regular-season career high with 10 catches for a season-high 97 yards vs. Min. (12/28/10)
- Produced one of the most prolific seasons by an Eagles TE in 2009, setting career highs with 76 receptions, 971 yards and 8 TDs. Among TEs in franchise history, only **Pete Retzlaff** (1,190 yards and 10 TDs in 1965) has recorded more receiving yards and TDs in a single season
- Celek (24 years old), **DeSean Jackson** (23) and **Jeremy Maclin** (21) became the first trio of teammates age 24-or-younger in NFL history to each post 50+ catches, 750+ yards and 4+ TDs in a single season in 2009. Celek and Jackson became the first duo in team history to each compile 900+ receiving yards in the same season
- Notched two straight 100+ yard receiving games (104 vs. NO - 9/20/09; 104 vs. KC - 9/27/09), becoming the first Eagles TE to accomplish the feat since **Pete Retzlaff** in 1965

Celek admits getting snubbed for the combine in 2007 was a huge motivating factor for him. "It ticked me off, to be honest. I thought I would be drafted higher, but it just lit a fire under me that I will always carry."

BRENT'S NO. 1 FAN

Celek's No. 1 fan is his grandfather, Ed, and vice versa. "We've been very close from when he was little on up," Ed said. Brent gave his grandfather the ball from his first TD in 2007. In fact, Prime Stache's menu contains a photo of Ed with a mustache.

'THE BUS'

Celek tries to model his game after one of the all-time great running backs: Hall of Famer Jerome Bettis. "I grew up watching Jerome Bettis and loved the way he played. He was a beast, the first guy never took him down. When I have the ball in my hands, I try to be like him. That's my mindset."

BIRDSEED

Celek and his wife, Celeste, reside in Philadelphia. His parents, Steve and Debbie, own three hair salons and spas in Cincinnati named Paragon Salon. Celek has two younger brothers: Garrett, who is a tight end for the San Francisco 49ers, and Tyler. He also has two younger sisters: Stephanie and Mackenzie.

Celek was a two-time all-district and all-league selection at La Salle High School (Cincinnati, OH) who also lettered in track and field, participating in the shotput and discus events. Celek began playing football in the 2nd grade as a fullback for Our Lady of Visitation (Cincinnati, OH).

Celek grew up a fan of the Cincinnati Bengals as his family owned 10 season tickets. His favorite Bengal of all time is Boomer Esiason. He also enjoyed watching Notre Dame football.
