COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Played in seven games as a senior in 2015 after breaking his ankle in the preseason. Was a first-team All-America selection by *CBS Sports* after finishing the season with 30 tackles, one sack and three pass breakups
- Started 12 games at safety and one at nickelback as a junior in 2014, and tallied 62 tackles, three tackles for loss, one interception and five pass breakups
- Picked up 67 tackles, three sacks and three interceptions over his 13 starts as a sophomore in 2013. His interception total tied for the team lead
- Earned 2012 Freshman first-team All-America honors after starting all 13 games at CB and finishing fourth on the team with 57 total tackles, while adding two interceptions and five pass breakups
