

Mitchell White signed a reserve/future contract with the Eagles on Jan. 9, 2017, after spending three seasons playing in the Canadian Football League. In 2016, White helped the Ottawa Redblacks capture the CFL's Grey Cup and led the team with 3 INTs. White was a four-year letterman at Michigan State and played in 43 career games for the Spartans. Following his college career, White was signed by the Oakland Raiders as an undrafted free agent and went to training camp with the club in 2013.

- A former walk-on at Michigan State, White earned a scholarship prior to the 2010 season. During his walk-on, freshman year, he appeared in the final 4 games of the season and was named Scout Team Offensive Player of the Week vs. Illinois
- In 2008, Mitchell competed in four track and field meets for the Spartans during the indoor season and competed in the Big Ten Championships
- Has an identical twin, Myles, who is currently a wide receiver for the New York Jets. Following high school, Mitchell and Myles both went to Michigan State and were Spartans teammates for two seasons (2008-09). Myles finished his college career at Louisiana Tech and entered the NFL in 2013 as an undrafted free agent with the Green Bay Packers. He split time between the Packers active roster and practice squad in 2013 and 2014. In 2015, he appeared in 12 games for the New York Giants.
- Played quarterback at Stevenson High School in Livonia, MI. Led his team to the Division 1 state finals as a senior in 2007 and threw for 1,433 yards and 18 TDs to just 3 INTs
- Also a four-year member of the track and field team at Stevenson and earned All-America honors in the high jump and won the 2008 state title as a senior
- Son of Michael and Karen White. His father, Michael, ran track at Michigan State

CFL HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 42 career games in the CFL and recorded 97 tackles and 4 INTs
- Played for the Ottawa Redblacks in 2016 and won a Grey Cup title. Despite missing the first four games of the season, led the Redblacks with 3 INTs and finished the season with 38 tackles
- Spent the 2014 and 2015 seasons with the Montreal Alouettes. Appeared in 28 games for Montreal and tallied 59 tackles and an INT

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Was a four-year letterwinner for the Spartans and played in 43 career games. Recorded 26 tackles
- Played in all 13 games as a senior in 2013 and notched 7 tackles and 4 tackles on special teams
