Originally a 5th-round draft choice of the Miami Dolphins in 2013, **Caleb Sturgis** was signed by the Eagles following Week 3 of the 2015 regular season and has developed into one of the top kickers in the NFL. Sturgis totaled a career-high and Eagles single-season record 35 FGs in 2016, which tied for 2nd in the NFL trailing only **Justin Tucker** (38). A four-year letterman at the University of Florida, Sturgis was a two-time finalist for the coveted Lou Groza Award (2011-12).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Set an Eagles record with 35 FGs in 2016, which also tied for the 2nd-highest total in the NFL. His 135 points ranked 4th in the NFL and were the 5th-highest total ever by an Eagles kicker
- Made four 50+ yard FGs in 2016, tying **Cody Parkey** (4 in 2014) for the team record in that category
- Connected on 18 consecutive FG attempts in 2016, which is a career high and the 2nd-longest streak in team history
- Despite heavy winds, tied a career high after making all 4 FG attempts at Bal. (12/18/16)
- Went 3-for-3 at Dal. (10/30/16), including a career-long 55-yarder that ranks as the 3rd-longest FG in Eagles history
- Nailed all 3 FG attempts at Det. (10/9/16), including his 10th-career 50+ yarder and 4th as an Eagle

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Connected on all 3 of his attempts, including a 53-yarder at Chi. (9/19/16), tying for the 2nd-longest field goal of his career and the 5th-longest in team history
- Booted 2 FGs in a win at Dal. (11/8/15), including a 53-yarder which tied the 2nd-longest kick of his career. He became just the second Eagle ever with a 50+ yard FG in back-to-back games and the first since **Tom Dempsey** in 1971. His go-ahead 53-yarder late in the fourth quarter tied for the 5th-longest in team history
- Connected on all 4 of his FG attempts vs. NO (10/11) to tie a career high. Became the 12th Eagles kicker to have 4 FGs in a game, but just the second to do so by his second game with the team (**Paul McFadden** in 1984)
- Finished 2nd in Dolphins single-season history with 128 points in 2014, while connecting on 29-of-37 FGs (78.4%) and 41-of-41 extra point attempts

BIRDSEED

Sturgis grew up in a family with six children (two girls, four boys), who were all homeschooled by his mom, Karen. His dad, Smiley, is a pastor at Good News Church in St. Augustine. During the offseason, Sturgis spends some of his free time helping his dad at Good News Church.

Sturgis met his wife, Kimberly, at the University of Florida, where she was a cheerleader. She is currently a fitness instructor in Gainesville, FL. The couple had a daughter, Cora, in the 2017 offseason.

Sturgis enjoys golf and other leisure sports. "Whether it's golf or cornhole, I'm very competitive."

BROTHERLY LOVE

Sturgis says the biggest influence on his career has been his older brother, Nathan, who is a Major League Soccer player who last played for the Seattle Sounders in 2016.

"It's been great to be able to learn from somebody who is also playing a professional sport."

HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

Sturgis attended St. Augustine (FL) High School, where he earned first-team Class 3A All-State honors as a senior placekicker.

Sturgis did not start playing football until his sophomore year in high school when his high school coach approached him about it. He went on to hit a 49-yard FG that year in Sun Life Stadium, which is when he realized he had a potential future as a kicker.

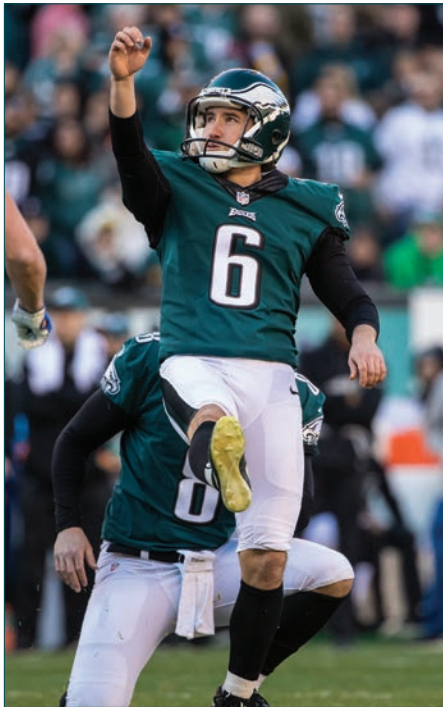
Sturgis also competed as a forward on St. Augustine's soccer team and for the Julington Creek club.

Growing up in St. Augustine, FL, Sturgis was a big fan of the Jacksonville Jaguars as a kid and even went to their training camp practices when he was 8 years old. His first jerseys were Mark Brunell and Natrone Means.

Sturgis always seems to enjoy his most successful games in his home state of Florida. As a sophomore in high school, he hit a 49-yarder in Sun Life Stadium. He later hit a career-long 56 yarder as a sophomore at Florida against Georgia at EverBank Field. Several of his 50+ yarders in the NFL have come in the state of Florida as well.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Booted a game-winning 26-yard FG with 1:57 left in the fourth quarter at NYJ (12/1/14), the first game-winning kick in the fourth quarter or overtime of his career
- Connected on a career-high 4-of-4 FGs vs. NE (9/7/14)
- As a rookie in 2013, led the Dolphins in scoring with 111 points and earned *Pro Football Weekly*/Pro Football Writers of America All-Rookie Team honors after connecting on 26-of-34 FGs and all 33 extra point attempts
- Hit 3 FGs of 50+ yards, including a 54 yarder at Ind. (9/15/13), becoming the only Dolphins rookie to connect on three 50-yard FGs in team history
- Booted FGs of 46 and 50 yards vs. Atl. (9/22/13), becoming just the second rookie kicker in team history to connect on 2 FGs of 50+ yards in a season
- Connected on a 54-yard FG at Ind. (9/15/13), which tied for the 4th-longest regular-season field goal in Dolphins history and the 2nd-longest kick by a Dolphins rookie
- Made his NFL debut at Cle. (9/8/13) and scored 11 points, going 3-for-3 on FGs, which tied for the 2nd-most FGs in a game by a Dolphins rookie behind **Dan Carpenter** (4 - 11/2/08 at Den.)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- A four-year letterman at Florida, connected on 70-of-88 career FG attempts (79.5%) and finished his collegiate career with 340 points. Set Florida career records in both made FGs (70) and FG attempts (88)
- Was a three-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll
- As a redshirt senior in 2012, set a school single-season record with 24 FGs on 28 attempts and was named the SEC co-Special Teams Player of the Year and a finalist for the Lou Groza Award, which is given annually to the nation's top placekicker
- Hit 3-of-3 FGs of 50+ yards as a senior
- As a redshirt junior in 2011, was a first-team All-American and All-SEC selection and a finalist for the Lou Groza Award after making 22-of-26 FGs with a long of 55 yards, the 3rd-longest make in the country that season. Also finished 3rd in the country with 22 made FGs in 2011
- Played in 14 games as a sophomore in 2009, hitting 22-of-30 FGs including a career-long 56 yarder vs. Georgia (10/31/09), the SEC's longest made field goal of the year
