Torrey Smith was signed by the Philadelphia Eagles to a three-year contract on March 10, 2017, following a two-year stint with the San Francisco 49ers. Originally selected by the Ravens in the 2nd round (58th overall) of the 2011 NFL Draft, Smith was a member of Baltimore's Super Bowl XLVII-winning team. The seventh-year wideout has totaled 266 catches for 4,521 yards (17.0 avg.) and 37 TDs in 92 career games, while posting 414 yards and 4 TDs on 20 receptions (20.7 avg.) in eight career postseason contests.

## TORREY SMITH FAMILY FUND

The Torrey Smith Family Fund is a nonprofit that aims to provide youth with the tools they need to identify, unleash and reach their full potential.

- In March 2017, Smith held his Sixth Annual Charity Basketball Game. All proceeds benefit the Torrey Smith Family Fund. The Smith family has been working in collaboration with established nonprofits and corporate partners to create important new programs in Baltimore.
- "Torrey's Back to School Program" is held each August with the purpose of ensuring that low-income elementary and middle school students have the basic items needed to begin the school year. Teachers also receive supplies they need to start the school year.
- In 2016, the Smiths began their mentoring programs geared towards high school boys in need of support and guidance with the launch of the L.E.V.E.L. (Leadership, Education, Vision, Effort, Love) Teen Summit. In total, thirty students participated in the overnight weekend Summit which included various workshops and presentations that focused on character building, decision making, leadership, and goal setting. Smith continues to meet with the youth on a monthly basis. The vision of the mentoring program is to introduce boys to positive male mentors, encourage students to pursue higher education and help them create a foundation for a successful future.
- During the 2016 offseason, Smith funded every school in East Baltimore to help give students the tools and opportunities they need to succeed. He appeared on the "Late Show with Stephen Colbert" to promote the effort.
- In partnership with Scholastic, and with the generosity of other corporations, the non-profit created reading rooms in five different Baltimore schools. The program enhances literacy by providing over 1200 age-appropriate books to the children in these schools. The rooms provide a vibrant and comfortable place for students to read or borrow a book.
- In honor of Torrey's late brother, Tevin Jones, the Torrey Smith Family Fund awards four annual college scholarships to high school seniors. Recipients of the scholarship are awarded \$5,000, distributed over four years

## MAN OF THE YEAR

Smith has been selected as his team's Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year nominee three times (2016 with San Francisco; 2013-14 with Baltimore). Named after the late Hall of Fame running back of the Chicago Bears, the Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year Award is given annually to the player who best exemplifies a commitment to philanthropy and community involvement.

"I've been giving back since day one, even when my family was the one receiving help. I always felt like your time was just as important as your money. I know what a lot of these families are going through and what a lot of these kids are going through. I wanted to be that support system for them, and that's why it's important for me to give back."

## MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Smith used his time and resources to help those affected by the contaminated water supply in Flint, MI, during the 2016 offseason. Despite having no ties to Michigan, Smith and former teammate, Justin Forsett, teamed with The United Way, who helped coordinate school visits along with the donation of bottled water to Loving Hands, which is an adult and senior care service.

## BIRDSEED

Smith (born James Torrey Smith) and his wife, Chanel (who grew up in Conshohocken, PA, and attended Plymouth-Whitemarsh HS), have two sons: Torrey Jeremiah (T.J.) and Kameron James. Smith, the oldest of seven children in his family, graduated with a bachelor's degree in criminology and criminal justice from the University of Maryland in 2010. In 2017, Smith, along with his wife, earned their MBA from the University of Miami.

During his time at Stafford HS (Falmouth, VA), Smith played wide receiver, running back and cornerback and saw action as a kick returner. Smith also played basketball in high school.

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- A member of Baltimore's Super Bowl XLVII-winning team that defeated San Francisco, 34-31, in New Orleans on 2/3/13. Caught 11 passes for 233 yards (21.2 avg.) and 2 TDs during the Ravens' playoff run
- His 20.70 receiving average in the postseason ranks 6th in NFL history, trailing only **Alvin Harper** (27.29, 1991-99), **Willie Gault** (23.67, 1983-93), **Harold Jackson** (22.83, 1968-83), **Vernon Davis** (22.22) and **Charlie Brown** (20.74, 1982-87) (min. 20 receptions)
- Since 2011, ranks 2nd in the NFL in yards per reception (17.0), trailing only **DeSean Jackson** (17.4) (min. 200 receptions)
- Ranks 2nd in the NFL in first-down receiving average (17.4) since 2011, trailing only **DeSean Jackson** (18.4) (min. 100 receptions). Also in that span, ranks 3rd in third-down receiving average (17.1), behind **Victor Cruz** (17.6) and **Jordy Nelson** (17.2) (min. 60 receptions)

### 2015 - SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS (16/12)

- Led the NFL with 20.1 yards per reception in his debut season with the 49ers (min. 30 receptions)
- Became the first 49er to register 3 receiving TDs of 70+ yards in a single season since **John Taylor** in 1989. At the time, became the first NFL player to accomplish the feat since **Josh Gordon** in 2013 (*Elias Sports Bureau*)
- Caught a career-long 76-yard TD from 49ers QB **Colin Kaepernick** vs. Bal. (10/18/15)

### 2014 - BALTIMORE RAVENS (16/16, 2/2)

- Finished his time in Baltimore as the club's career leader in receiving average (16.9), totaling 213 receptions for 3,591 yards and 30 TDs from 2011-14
- Produced a team-leading, career-high 11 TDs, becoming the first Raven to record 10+ receiving TDs since **Michael Jackson** (14 in 1996)

### 2013 - BALTIMORE RAVENS (16/16)

- Tallied career highs in receptions (65) and receiving yards (1,128), becoming the first Raven to reach 1,000+ receiving yards in a single season since **Derrick Mason** (1,028 in 2009)
- Became the first Raven to post back-to-back 100+ yard receiving games since **Qadry Ismail** (3 in 1999) after leading the team with 121 yards on 6 catches at Mia. (10/6/13)
- Totaled a career-high 166 yards and 1 TD on 5 receptions (33.2 avg.) at Buf. (9/29/13)

### 2012 - BALTIMORE RAVENS (16/16, 4/4)

- Led the Ravens with 98 yards and 2 TDs on 3 receptions (32.7 avg.) in the AFC Divisional game at Den. (1/12/13). His 2 TDs set a Ravens single-game postseason record
- Started all 16 games for the first time in his career, posting 49 catches for 855 yards and a team-high 8 TDs
- Following the loss of his 19-year-old brother, Tevin Jones, the morning of the game, led the Ravens with 6 receptions for 127 yards and 2 TDs in a 31-30 win vs. NE (9/23/12)

### 2011 - BALTIMORE RAVENS (16/14, 2/1)

- In his first career playoff game, notched 3 receptions for 82 yards (27.3 avg.) and his first career postseason TD in the AFC Championship game at NE (1/22/12)
