In 2017, Sidney Jones (43rd overall pick) became the highest-drafted Eagles CB since Lito Sheppard (26th overall pick) in 2002.

Sidney Jones was selected by the Eagles in the 2nd round (43rd overall) of the 2017 NFL Draft. Jones started 39 of 40 career games at the University of Washington, where he amassed 145 tackles (105 solo), 30 PDs, 9 INTs, 6 FFs and 3 FRs. The California native was a two-time first-team All-Pac-12 selection (2015-16) and earned second-team All-America honors (*Sports Illustrated*, *Football Writers*) in 2016.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2016, was named second-team All-America (*Sports Illustrated*, *Football Writers*) while garnering first-team All-Pac-12 accolades
- Started all 14 games of the 2016 season and finished with 9 PDs, 3 INTs and 2 FFs. Made 7 tackles in the win at Arizona (9/24/16), earning himself the team's defensive player of the week honors. Named the Pac-12 Player of the Week after intercepting two passes and adding two other PDs in a win at California (11/5/16). Totaled 3 tackles and 1 FF in the Pac-12 Championship Game victory vs. Colorado (12/2/16)
- In 2015, was named first-team All-Pac-12 while also earning second-team Academic All-Pac-12 and CoSIDA District VIII Academic All-America first-team honors

Jones prepped at West Covina (CA) High School, where he was named Hacienda League Defensive Player of the Year and earned first-team All-CIF Southern Section Southeast Division honors at defensive back as a senior in 2013. Jones, who played cornerback, free safety, running back and wide receiver while also returning kicks and punts for the Bulldogs, helped lead West Covina into the CIF Southern Section Southeast Division playoffs that year as well.

As a junior in 2012, Jones received first-team All-CIF SS Southeast Division and first-team All-Hacienda League honors at defensive back and helped lead the Bulldogs to the CIF-SS Southeast Division semifinals. As a sophomore in 2011, West Covina finished the season 13-1 and won the CIF-SS Southeast Division, beating La Serna, 84-21, in the championship game. That squad scored 240 points in four postseason contests.

- Started all 13 games in 2015 and finished the year as the Pac-12 leader in PDs (14) while tying for 2nd in FFs (3), tying for 4th in INTs (4) and tying for 5th in FRs (2). Forced a fumble, picked it up and ran 70 yards for a TD vs. California (9/26/15). Returned a 35-yard INT for a TD against Utah (11/7/15). Notched a 69-yard INT-TD and three other PDs in the Apple Cup win over Washington State (11/27/15)
- In 2014, appeared in 13 contests (12 starts) as a true freshman. Logged 61 tackles (48 solo), 7 PDs, 2 INTs, 1 FF and 1 FR
