Shelton Gibson was selected by the Eagles in the 5th round (166th overall) of the 2017 NFL Draft. Gibson, who excelled as a receiver and kick returner during his three-year career at West Virginia, earned second-team All-Big 12 honors after totaling 43 receptions for 951 yards (22.1 avg.) and 8 TDs as a junior in 2016. In his sophomore campaign in 2015, Gibson registered 37 catches for 887 yards (24.0 avg.) and a career-high 9 TDs.

BIRDSEED

- Is the son of Shalett and Shelton Gibson. Has four siblings. Majored in multidisciplinary studies at West Virginia
- Prepped at Cleveland Heights HS (Cleveland, OH), where he finished with 700 receiving yards as a senior while scoring as a receiver, rusher, kickoff returner, punt returner and passed for a TD. Named No. 6 on the 2012 Cleveland Plain Dealer Top 50 Northeast Ohio football players. Also played in the U.S. Army All-American Bowl
- Grabbed 27 passes for 518 yards and 4 TDs as a junior in 2011. Recorded 45 receptions for 532 yards and 21 TDs as a sophomore
- Also lettered in track and field, participating in sprints and relays

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 38 games during his three-year career at West Virginia, where he amassed 84 receptions for 1,898 yards (22.6 avg.) and 17 TDs. Also had 53 kickoff returns for 1,244 yards (23.5 avg.) and 1 TD, including a 100-yard kick return TD
- Ranked 4th in the nation with 22.1 yards per reception as a junior in 2016, trailing only **Jalen Robinette** (27.4, Air Force), **Jester Weah** (24.2, Pittsburgh) and **Jaylen Smith** (22.2, Louisville). Registered career highs in receptions (43) and receiving yards (951) en route to second-team All-Big 12 honors
- Earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention as a sophomore in 2015 after ranking 2nd in the nation with 23.97 yards per reception, trailing only current Eagles teammate **Mack Hollins** (24.8, North Carolina). Produced 37 catches for 887 yards and a career-high 9 TDs. Returned 11 kickoffs for 361 yards (32.8 avg.), including a 100-yard TD at Baylor (10/17/15)

Among NCAA players with at least 20.0 yards per reception from 2015-16 (min. 40 receptions), Gibson ranks 1st with 17 TDs.
