A versatile threat in the collegiate ranks, **Trey Burton** originally signed with the Eagles as an undrafted free agent during the 2014 offseason. Burton has been a key member of the Eagles special teams units over the past four seasons, recording 36 special teams tackles, a blocked punt, blocked punt return TD, forced fumble, fumble recovery and onside kick recovery. In 2016, Burton registered career highs with 37 catches for 327 yards and also added his first career receiving TD.

2017 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (9/1)

- Posted the longest TD reception (27 yards) of his career in the 51-23 win vs. Den. (11/5/17)
- Caught a 15-yard TD pass from **Carson Wentz** on the opening drive in the 34-7 win vs. Ari. (10/8/17)
- Recovered an Eagles onside kick by **Jake Elliott** with :05 remaining in the game at KC (9/17/17). Marked the team's first successful onside kick since 12/30/12 at NYG (**Alex Henery** kick recovered by **Brandon Hughes**)
- Notched the 2nd special teams fumble recovery of his NFL career on a muffed punt return by Redskins WR **Jamison Crowder** at Was. (9/10/17). The takeaway set up a TD drive that gave the Eagles a 13-0 lead in the second quarter

2016 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (15/4)

- Produced career highs in receptions (37), receiving yards (327) and offensive snaps played (331, 29%) in 2016
- Forced the first fumble of his career when he stripped the ball loose from Ravens KR **Chris Moore** on a kick return in the second quarter at Bal. (12/18/16)
- Made his first-career NFL start at Was. (10/16/16)
- Hauled in his first-career TD off a 2-yard pass from QB **Carson Wentz** in the third quarter at Chi. (9/19/16). Totaled career highs with 5 receptions for 49 yards

2015 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/0)

- Finished the 2015 season with a team-high 19 special teams tackles, which is tied for the highest total by an Eagle in the regular season since 2009

HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

As a senior at Venice (FL) High School in 2009, Burton threw for 1,876 yards, 18 TDs and 1 INT and rushed for 821 yards and 22 TDs, earning FSWA 5A All-State First-Team honors. Burton also garnered all-state honors after passing for 1,399 yards and 12 TDs and recording 919 yards and 24 TDs on the ground. Burton also played basketball and ran track at Venice HS.

PHILLY APPRECIATION

Burton has a great appreciation for Philadelphia's history and enjoys exploring the city in his free time. "I was never exposed to anything like this when I was growing up."

BIRDSEED

Burton is the son of Cindy Burton and has two brothers, Clay Burton (who played collegiately at Florida and went to training camp with the Buffalo Bills in 2015) and Jake MacFarland. Burton and his wife, Yesenia, have three children. Burton graduated from Florida with a bachelor's degree in family, youth and community science.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Notched the first 2 receptions of his NFL career at Det. (11/26/15), including a 43-yarder in the first quarter
- Earned a spot on the 2014 **PFWA All-Rookie team** as a special teams player. Had 7 special teams tackles

2014 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (15/0)

- Returned a blocked punt for 27 yards for the first TD of his career at NYG (12/28/14)
- Filled in at running back for an injured **Darren Sproles** vs. NYG (10/12/14) and rushed 5 times for 10 yards
- Blocked an **Andy Lee** punt in the end zone at SF (9/28/14) that was recovered for a TD by teammate **Brad Smith**. It was the first blocked punt for a TD by the Eagles since 1992

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 50 games (29 starts) during his collegiate tenure, finishing his career with 720 rushing yards and 16 TDs on 141 carries and 107 catches for 976 yards and 4 TDs
- As a senior captain in 2013, tallied 38 receptions for 445 yards and 1 TD as a full-time wide receiver



FATHER FIGURES

Burton claims the biggest influences on his life were a trio of mentors: his late grandfather, John McClintock, and two of his high school coaches, John Peacock and Larry Shannon.

"They kept me going in the right direction. I didn't have a father growing up, so they were my father figures through high school. If I ever needed anything or need anything to this day, I can always go to them and ask for anything."

NFL FAMILY TREE

Burton's grandfather, Lawrence Burton, was the 7th-overall pick in the 1975 NFL Draft and also sprinted for Team USA in the 1972 Summer Olympics in Munich.

Lawrence split time with new Orleans and San Diego during a five-year NFL career, hauling in 44 catches for 804 yards and 7 TDs. Additionally, he placed 4th for the United States in Munich in the 200-meter final.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Appeared in 12 games (four starts) as a junior, registering 190 yards and 2 TDs on 29 carries and 18 catches for 172 yards and 1 TD
- Joined Chris Rainey as the only Gators to score both a rushing and receiving TD in the same game as a sophomore in 2010. Finished the season with 19 catches for 149 yards and one TD, while adding 125 yards and 3 TDs on 37 carries
- Named to the 2010 SEC All-Freshman Team and was SEC Freshman Player of the Week twice during the season
- Saw action at quarterback, fullback, tight end, wide receiver and on kick coverage while starting 11 games as a freshman in 2010. Recorded a team-high 11 rushing TDs on 75 carries and also led the Gators with 12 total TDs
- Ranked 3rd among Florida freshmen in school history with 12 total TDs and 2nd with 11 rushing TDs, trailing only **Emmitt Smith**
- Scored 6 total TDs (5 rushing, 1 receiving) in a single game against Kentucky (9/25/10), despite only touching the ball 10 times. Was only the fourth player in SEC history to score 36 or more points in a single game
