A veteran of 13 NFL seasons, **Donnie Jones** signed with the Eagles in 2013 and quickly solidified himself as the top punter in franchise history in terms of both gross and net punting average. 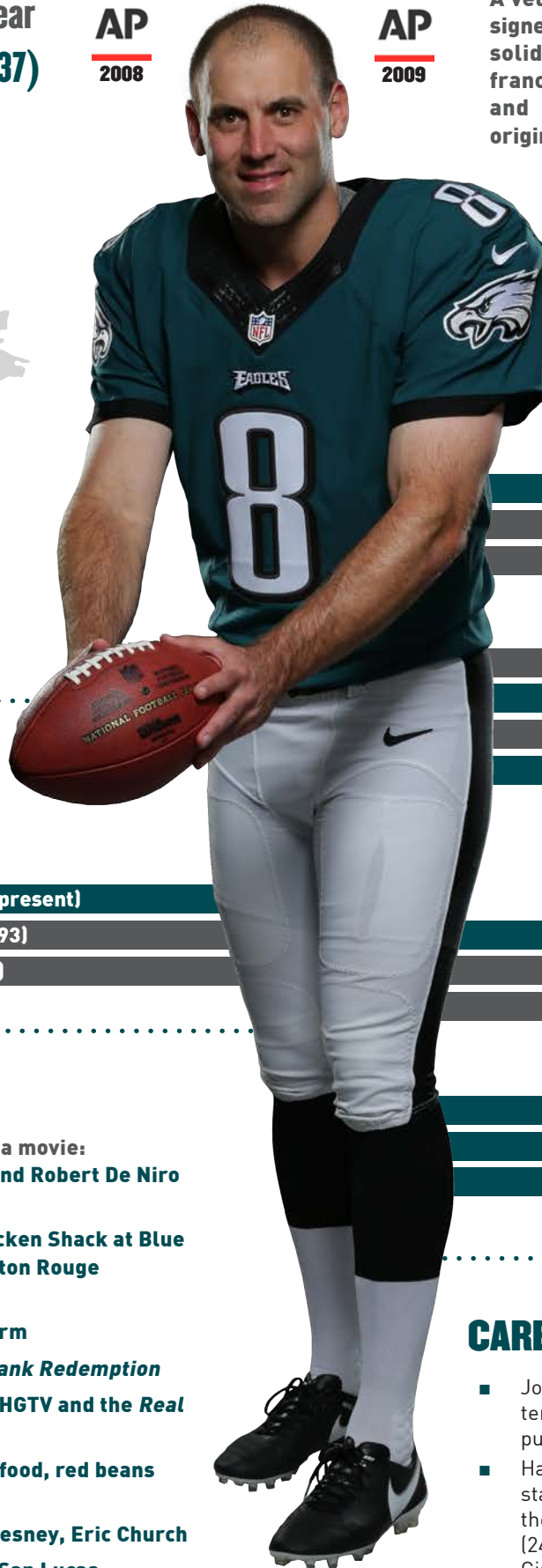

- One of only seven players in NFL history to record a 50.0 gross avg. in a single season, accomplishing the feat in 2008 with St. Louis
- Garnered second-team **All-Pro** honors in both 2008 and 2009 while with the Rams and was also selected to the 2008 *USA Today All-Joe team*
- Set Texans' team records with a gross average of 47.2 yards and a net average of 40.5 yards during his lone season with Houston in 2012
- Holds Rams' records in punts, gross avg. and net avg.



AVID GOLFER

Jones enjoys golfing in his spare time and plays four to five times a week during the offseason. If he could have one talent, he would love to be able to play professionally. "I'd like to be a really good golfer and play on the PGA tour. I'm not bad. I have my good days and my bad, but I love it."

Jones has had the opportunity to play two of the most prestigious golf courses in the world - Merion and Pine Valley. He says his ideal foursome to play a round with would be himself, Arnold Palmer, Jack Nicklaus and Tiger Woods.

HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

Jones earned all-state and all-district honors as a senior at Baton Rouge Catholic, where he averaged 43.4 yards per punt on a team that reached the Class 5A semifinals. Jones says the last time he scored a touchdown was in 1998.

Jones also threw the javelin and participated in the high jump at Baton Rouge Catholic.

FAMILY MAN

Jones' greatest love besides football is his family. "Definitely my family. That's something that's very important to me, especially when you have kids. It's so important to be that positive influence for them. I love being able to spend time with them away from football, whether it's going to their games or on vacations with the whole family. It's great to be able to spend quality time with them and help create memories that our kids will have forever."

BIRDSEED

Jones, who resides in Baton Rouge, LA, in the offseason, is the son of Amanda and Don Jones and has one sister, Mandy. Jones and his wife, Aubrie, have a son, Weston, a daughter, Addison, and also have one dog, a poodle named Rilie.

Jones graduated from LSU with a degree in finance.

Jones' nickname is "Donnie Longball," which was given to him by former teammate Connor Barwin.

- Set an Eagles record and tied a career high with 34 punts inside the 20-yard line, surpassing his previous record of 33 set in 2013. That total also tied Arizona's **Drew Butler** for the NFL lead
- Booted a 68-yarder vs. Dal. (12/14/14), tying for the third-longest punt of his career
- His 53.8-yard gross average at Ind. (9/15/14) was the third-highest single-game average in Eagles history
- In 2013, ranked first in Eagles history in single-season net punting average (40.4) and third in gross punting average (44.9)

2013 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/0, Playoffs: 1/0)

- Led the NFL with 27 punts downed without a return and finished tied for fourth in the league with a franchise-best 33 punts inside the 20-yard line
- Recorded a 48.8-yard gross average vs. NO (1/4/14), which ranked as the fourth-highest in Eagles postseason history

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- With his seven punts inside the 20, Jones set a team record and tied the third-highest total in the NFL since the stat became official in 1976. He averaged 44.3 yards (43.9 net) on eight kicks, including a 69-yard boot
- Became just the second Philadelphia punter (**Sean Landeta**, 2001) to earn **NFC Special Teams Player of the Week** honors after he set a team single-game record with a 50.7 net average vs. Was. (11/17/13). Jones booted a 70-yard punt late in the fourth quarter to pin the Redskins at their own 4-yard line to start their final drive of the game. Was the longest by an Eagle since **Randall Cunningham's** 80 yarder at Dal. (10/16/94)

2012 - HOUSTON TEXANS (16/0, Playoffs: 2/0)

- Established Texans franchise records with a gross average of 47.2 yards and a net average of 40.5 yards
- Recorded a franchise-best 54.2 yards per punt vs. Den. (9/23/12)

2011 - ST. LOUIS RAMS (16/0)

- Punted 105 times for 4,652 yards and an average of 44.3 yards per punt

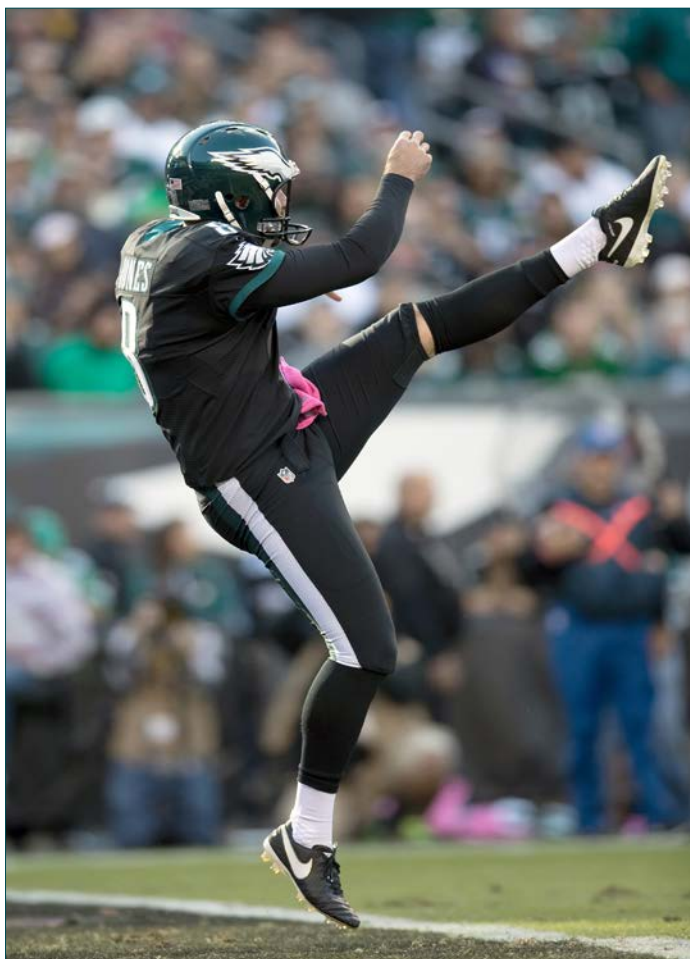

- Did not allow a punt to be returned after booting a season-high 10 punts for an average of 43.7 yards per kick at SF (11/14/10). Only NFL punter to produce a game with no return yards on nine or more punts during the 2010 season

2009 - ST. LOUIS RAMS (16/0)

- **Second-team All-Pro** selection by the *Associated Press* for the second consecutive year after finishing the season with a career-high 34 punts inside the 20-yard line
- His 34 punts inside the 20-yard line in 2009 are a Rams' single-season record, surpassing **Dale Hatcher's** record of 32 punts inside the 20 established in 1985
- His 48.0-yard career gross average is the top mark in franchise history, surpassing the previous team-high of 44.3 yards established by **Danny Villanueva** from 1961-64
- Booted a career-high 11 punts for 551 yards vs. SF (1/3/10)
- Punted seven times for an average of 45.3 yards at Chi. (12/6/09), including a then-career-high six punts inside the 20-yard line, most in franchise history
- Registered a 56.3-yard average, breaking his own single-game franchise record for gross punting average vs. Ari. (11/22/09)

2008 - ST. LOUIS RAMS (16/0)

- **Second-team All-Pro** selection by the *Associated Press*, finishing the season with a 50-yard gross average, registering 4,100 yards on 82 punts. His 50-yard gross average stands as the Rams franchise record for a single season, breaking his previous mark of 47.2 set in 2007
- Became only the second player in NFL history to record a 50-yard gross punting average, joining Hall of Famer **Sammy Baugh** who averaged 51.4 yards in 1940
