Corey Clement signed with the Eagles as an undrafted free agent during the 2017 offseason and was the only undrafted rookie to make the Eagles opening-day, 53-man roster. Clement spent four years at Wisconsin and was a member of the winningest senior class in Badgers history (41-13, .759). He amassed 3,092 rushing yards and finished 8th all-time in career rushing average (5.4) and 9th in rushing TDs (36).

BIRDSEED

- Is the son of Latanya and Steve Clement. Interned at Merrill Lynch during the summer of 2016. Majored in life sciences communication at the University of Wisconsin
- Prepped at Glassboro HS (Glassboro, NJ), where he was coached by Mark MacCarone. Selected to the Semper Fidelis All-American Bowl after finishing his high school career with an outstanding 6,245 rushing yards, 34 rushing TDs and 90 total TDs
- Earned first-team all-state honors after rushing for 2,323 yards and 33 TDs while also recording 47 tackles and 8.0 sacks as a senior. Set the New Jersey state record with 479 yards against Gloucester City. Ran for 2,510 yards and 36 total TDs as a junior. Tallied 1,205 rushing yards and 15 TDs as a sophomore

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Hauled in 5 passes in the 2017 Divisional Playoff win vs. Atl. (1/13/18) to become the first Eagles rookie to record 5+ receptions in a playoff game since **Jeremy Maclin** caught 7 passes at Dal. (1/9/10). Is the first undrafted Eagle to accomplish the feat
- 2017 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/0, Playoffs: 1/0)**
 - Recorded a team-high 5 receptions for 31 yards in the Divisional Playoff win vs. Atl. (1/13/18). His 5 catches marked a single-game career high for the rookie. Also registered 3 first downs in the win
 - Became the first undrafted rookie with at least 2 TDs rushing and receiving since **Jed Collins** (Saints) in 2011
 - Is the first Eagles rookie RB to record multiple receiving TDs in a season since **Junior Tautalatasi** (2) in 1986

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Scored his 6th TD of the season (4th rushing) on the Eagles' opening drive of the second half at Dal. (11/19/17). Tacked on the first two-point conversion of his career when he punched the ball in following his own score
- Had a career game in Week 9 vs. Den. (11/5/17). Carried 12 times for 51 yards and 2 TDs. Added a 15-yard TD catch to give him 3 total TDs on the day. He became the first Eagle to record 2+ rushing TDs and 1+ receiving TD in a game since **Brian Westbrook** on 11/27/08 vs. Ari. and became the first Eagles rookie to accomplish the feat since **Don Johnson** in 1953
- Led the team in rushing with 54 yards vs. SF (10/29/17)
- Made an acrobatic catch and got his feet down in the end zone on a 9-yard TD pass from QB **Carson Wentz** in the third quarter vs. Was. (10/23/17). The score marked his first career receiving TD and gave the Eagles a 24-10 lead
- Logged career highs in carries (10) and rushing yards (30) in the team's Week 4 win at LAC (10/1/17)
- Received his first NFL carries in the team's Week 3 win vs. NYG (9/24/17) and scored the first TD of his career on a 15-yard run in the 4th quarter. His score tied the game at 21-21 with less than 6 minutes remaining in regulation
- Led the Eagles with a team-high 2 special teams tackles in his NFL debut at Was. (9/10/17)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- A member of the winningest senior class in Wisconsin history (41-13, .759). Rushed for 3,092 yards and 36 TDs on 576 attempts (5.4 avg.) while adding 29 catches for 279 yards and 2 TDs in 43 career games (15 starts)
- Finished 8th in school history in career rushing average and 9th in career rushing TDs
- Earned first-team All-Big Ten honors from the league's coaches after recording career highs with 314 carries for 1,375 yards (4.3 avg.) and 15 TDs in 13 games (all starts) as a senior in 2016. Tallied eight 100+ yard rushing games, including five straight to end the season. Rushed for a career-high-tying 164 yards vs. Ohio State (10/15/16) and vs. Penn State (12/3/16)
- Played in all 14 games (one start) as a sophomore in 2014, rushing 147 times for 949 yards (6.5 avg.) and 9 TDs. Combined with **Melvin Gordon** (2,587 yards) to set the single-season FBS record for rushing yards by teammates at 3,536 yards (breaking the record of 3,053 set by Gordon and **James White** in 2013). Registered a career-high 164 yards vs. Illinois (11/11/14)
