Originally selected by the Eagles in the 4th round (125th overall) of the 2018 NFL Draft, **Avonte Maddox** was one of the top defensive backs in the Atlantic Coast Conference during his time at the University of Pittsburgh. In 46 career games, Maddox produced 183 tackles (136 solo), 42 PDs, 8 INTs (including 2 TDs), 7.0 sacks, 3 FFs and 1 FR. From 2015-17, the Detroit native's 8 INTs led the Panthers and tied for 5th-most in the ACC in that span.

- Received Honorable Mention All-ACC recognition from the media after leading Pitt with 3 INTs and 15 PDs as a sophomore in 2015. Blocked an extra-point attempt in the Military Bowl (12/28/15). Had a career-high 4 PDs and 30-yard INT-TD vs. Louisville (11/21/15). Returned a kickoff 89 yards for a TD vs. Youngstown State (9/5/15)
