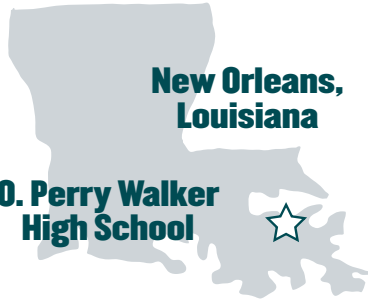

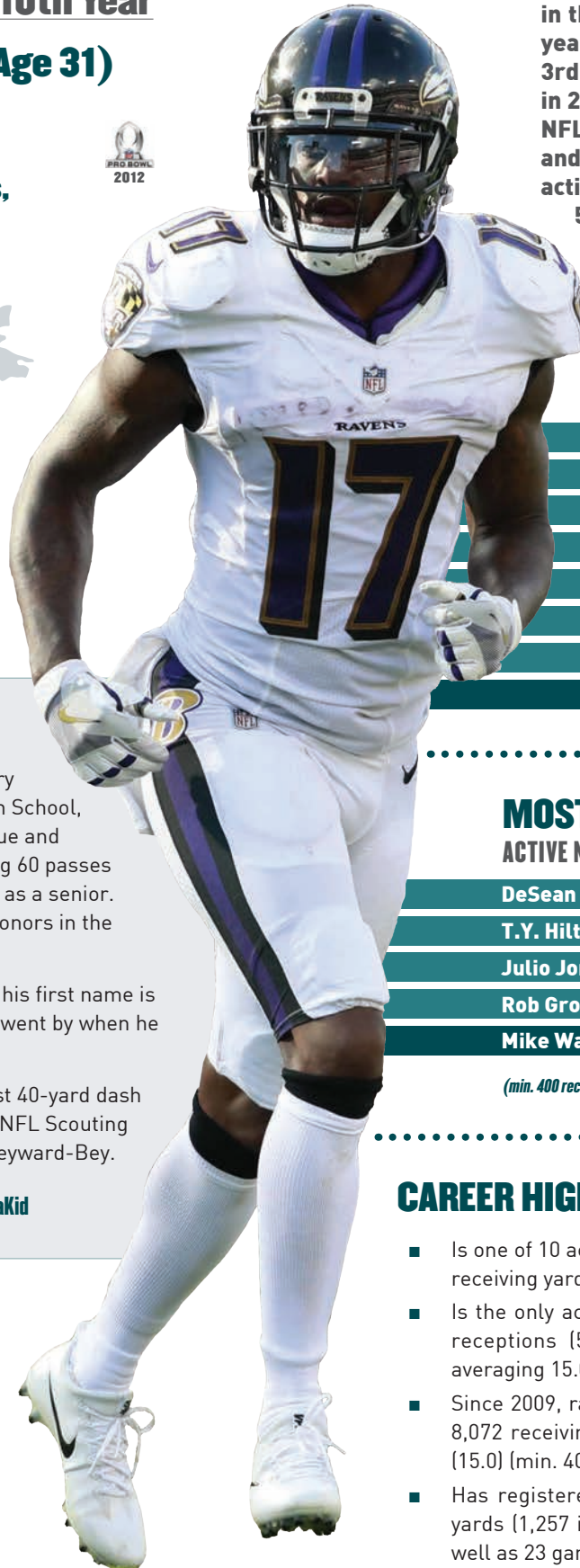

Mike Wallace signed with the Eagles in the 2018 offseason following a two-year stint with the Ravens. Originally a 3rd-round draft choice of the Steelers in 2009, Wallace is one of just 10 active NFL players with 8,000 receiving yards and 500 receptions. He is also the only active player to record 500 catches and 50 TDs while averaging 15.0 yards per reception.

Wallace prepped at O. Perry Walker (New Orleans) High School, where he was named league and district MVP after recording 60 passes for 1,039 yards and 19 TDs as a senior. He also earned All-State honors in the 100-meter dash in track.

Although he goes by Mike, his first name is actually Burnell, which he went by when he was in high school.

Wallace ran the 2nd-fastest 40-yard dash (4.28 seconds) at the 2009 NFL Scouting Combine, behind Darius Heyward-Bey.

In 2017, Wallace led the Ravens in receiving yards (748), receiving average (14.4) and receiving first downs (33) and tied for the team lead in receiving touchdowns (4).

2016 - BALTIMORE RAVENS (16/16)

- Registered his third career 1,000+ yard season, posting a team-leading 1,017 yards and 4 TDs on 72 receptions (14.1 avg.). Also led the NFL with 5 receptions of 50+ yards
- Produced a career-long (tied) 95-yard receiving TD in the 21-14 victory vs. Pit. (11/6/16), which marked the longest offensive play in Ravens history

2015 - MINNESOTA VIKINGS (16/12, 1/0)
