Originally selected by the Eagles in the 3rd round (84th overall) of the 2015 NFL Draft, **Jordan Hicks** enjoyed a breakout year in 2016, leading all NFL LBs with a career-high 5 INTs. Hicks, who has totaled 12 takeaways in 31 career games (28 starts), is tied for the 2nd-most INTs (7) by an NFL LB since 2015.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Is tied for 2nd among NFL LBs with 7 INTs since 2015, trailing only **Luke Kuechly** (8). Joins **Seth Joyner** (1986-88) and **Bob Pellegrini** (1956-59) as the only Eagles LBs to record 7 INTs in their first three NFL seasons
- Led all NFL LBs with a career-high 5 INTs in 2016

2017 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (7/7)

- Recovered the fumble on a strip-sack by **Fletcher Cox** at Was. (9/10/17), marking his 12th career takeaway
- Placed on Injured Reserve (Achilles) on 10/31/17

2016 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/16)

- Led all NFL LBs with a career-high 5 INTs, which is tied for the 4th-most by a non-defensive back in team history (most since **Bill Bergey** in 1974 - also 5)
- According to *Elias Sports Bureau*, became the first NFL LB to record 11+ takeaways in his first 24 career games (2015-16) since Hall of Famer **Jack Ham** (1971-72)
- Totaled a career-high 2 INTs vs. Dal. (1/1/17). Became the first Eagles LB to produce multiple INTs in a single game since **William Thomas** (2) on 9/22/96 at Atlanta

2015 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (8/5)

- Became the first NFL rookie to register opponent fumble recoveries in 3 consecutive games (9/27/15-10/11/15) since **Jack Del Rio** in 1985. Was the first Eagle to accomplish the feat since **Byron Evans** in 1993
- Returned an INT of Cowboys QB **Matt Cassell** for a 67-yard TD at Dal. (11/8/15), marking the longest INT-TD by an Eagles LB since **Shawn Barber** (80 yards) on 12/21/02 at Dallas and the first by an Eagles rookie since **Bill Bradley** (56 yards) on 10/19/69 at Dallas

In March 2018, Hicks joined teammate Chris Maragos and former teammate Trey Burton to launch **TopTier Wealth Management**, a wealth management firm that aides professional athletes with their financial planning. TopTier provides players and outside investors with financial and investment plans and will oversee retirement plans and second-career help. Hicks, Maragos and Burton are owners in the firm and will serve as player liaisons, helping mentor young players who need comprehensive advice.





HOW HE GOT HIS START

Hicks is the son of Scott Hicks, who coaches high school basketball in Indianapolis, and Kelly Justice. He has an older sister, Taylor, and three younger brothers: Scotty, Cameron and Ethan.

Hicks began his football career in the 5th grade while playing running back and safety in the Lexington Termites League in South Carolina. Hicks grew up a big fan of the Carolina Panthers and the University of Texas football team.

The best advice he was ever given growing up came from his mother, Kelly Justice, who always told him to “stay humble.”

EARLY MOTIVATION

Hicks was a three-year starter at Lakota West High School and earned numerous accolades, including the Butkus Award in 2009, given annually to the nation’s best linebacker. He was also named Gatorade’s Ohio High School Football Player of the Year.

Hicks also lettered in basketball and holds the district record for most varsity basketball games played in a career (87) and set the district record for steals (170).

ADAPTING TO CHANGE

Hicks was born in Colorado Springs, CO, and lived in Indiana (ages 1-6) and South Carolina (ages 6-11) before moving to Ohio. He also played for two head coaches and four defensive coordinators at Texas.

“Change does not scare me and I don’t take anything for granted. I also think I’m able to see the positives of every different situation I’m in. It’s enhanced my confidence and humility all at the same time.”

OFF THE FIELD

Hicks’ hobbies include playing video games, especially FIFA and NBA2K, as well as playing basketball and hanging out with friends by the lake in Austin, TX. Hicks married his wife, Ivana, during the 2017 offseason.

- Made his first career NFL start at NYJ (9/27/15), logging a career-high 14 tackles. Recorded a fourth-quarter INT of Jets QB **Ryan Fitzpatrick** and recovered a fumble by Jets WR **Brandon Marshall**. His INT was the first by an Eagles rookie LB since **Stewart Bradley** in 2009
- Pressed into his first career action on defense due to injuries to **Mychal Kendricks** and **Kiko Alonso** vs. Dal. (9/20/15). Registered a sack-fumble of Cowboys QB **Tony Romo**

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Recorded 147 tackles as a senior at Texas, which tied for the 7th-highest total in school annals (most since **Winfred Tubbs** notched 157 in 1992)
- Named honorable mention Big 12 Defensive Freshman of the Year by the conference’s coaches after appearing in all 12 games and totaling 23 tackles and 1.0 sack
- Earned first-team Academic All-Big 12 honors in 2014 and 2011 and was a seven-time member of the Big 12 Commissioner’s Honor Roll. Was also named to the 2015 NFF Hampshire Honor Society
