The Las Vegas native finished his career at San Diego State with the most rushing yards (6,405) in NCAA FBS history and also ranks 5th all-time in all-purpose yards (7,515), tied for 8th in overall TDs (67) and 9th in rushing TDs (62).

## COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Led the NCAA in rushing (2,133 yards) as a senior in 2016 and gained first-team All-America honors from Sports Illustrated. Named a Heisman candidate, Doak Walker Award finalist and a Maxwell Award and Walter Camp Player of the Year Award semifinalist. Became the first running back voted as the Mountain West Conference Offensive Player of the Year in consecutive seasons
- Named MWC Offensive Player of the Year and earned honorable mention All-America accolades from Sports Illustrated as a junior in 2015. Led the Aztecs with 1,653 rushing yards and 17 TDs on 309 attempts (5.3 avg.)
- Also had a team-high 28 catches for 416 yards (14.9 avg.) and 3 TDs in 2015. Was one of only four players in FBS to lead his team in rushing yards and receptions
- Garnered honorable mention All-America honors from Sports Illustrated and was a first-team All-MWC selection as a sophomore in 2014. Rushed for 1,867 yards and a career-high 20 TDs on 276 attempts (6.8 avg.)
