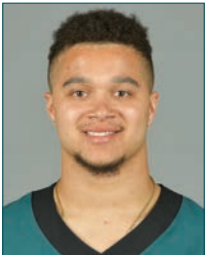

BIRDSEED: Prepped at Central Bucks South (PA) HS, where he was an all-state honoree at running back ... Rushed for 1,623 yards on 208 carries with 25 TDs as a senior in 2014 ... Rushed 257 times for 2,085 yards and 28 TDs as a sophomore in 2012, leading C.B. South to a 10-2 record and the Pennsylvania District 1 Class AAA quarterfinals

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Helped lead Notre Dame to a 2018 Citrus Bowl victory over LSU ... Finished his Fighting Irish career with 481 rushes for 3,198 yards (6.6 avg.) and 20 TDs ... Ranks 5th all-time in Notre Dame history in rushing yards (3,198) ... Ranks 3rd in school history for 100+ rushing yard games (15) ... Quickest running back in Notre Dame history to reach 1,000 and 2,000 rushing yards by carries ... Recorded the best single season by a Fighting Irish running back in the last 20 years, totaling 1,430 rushing yards (110.0 ypg) in 2017 ... Four out of his five best rushing performances came against nationally-ranked opponents ... Set the Notre Dame record for rushing yards by a freshman in 2015 (835) ... Recorded the longest play from scrimmage by a freshman in Notre Dame and NCAA history (98) ... Was included in multiple award watchlists such as the Doak Walker Award, Maxwell Award and the Heisman Trophy

Part of a Western Michigan defense that helped lead the program to its first ever BCS bowl game, where they appeared in the Cotton Bowl against Wisconsin in 2016 ... Earned All-MAC honors in 2015, 2016 and 2017 ... Led the Broncos in tackles in 2015 (103) and 2017 (98) ... Recorded 22 tackles in his last game against Toledo, which was the 3rd-highest single-game total in the FBS in 2017 ... Ranked 4th in the MAC in solo tackles (65) in 2016 ...
