Ajayi was born in London, England, to his father, Ibi, and mother, Kemi, who are both natives of Nigeria. Ajayi was raised in Texas and prepped at Liberty (Frisco, TX) High School, where he earned two letters in football and one in track and field.

As a senior, Ajayi was named second-team all-state and was voted as a Parade All-American after recording 225 carries for 2,240 yards (10.0 avg.) and 35 TDs. As a junior, Ajayi tallied 209 carries for 1,627 yards (7.8 avg.) and 20 TDs.

In track and field, Ajayi was a member of the 4x400m, 4x200m and 4x100m district championship track teams.

Ajayi was a member of the National Society of High School Scholars. Ajayi has served as a NFL UK Ambassador, making appearances on BBC Sports and Sky Sports.

- Between Miami (465) and Philadelphia (408), became the first player in NFL history to produce 400+ rushing yards with two different teams in the same regular season
- Led the Eagles with 91 rushing yards on 7 attempts (13.0 avg.) in the 37-9 win at Dal. (11/19/17), including a career-long 71-yard run in the third quarter
- Posted a 46-yard rushing TD vs. Den. (11/5/17)
- Started each of his 7 games with the Dolphins and rushed 138 times for 465 yards, including a 130-yard game at Atl. (10/15/17) and 122-yard game at LAC (9/17/17)
