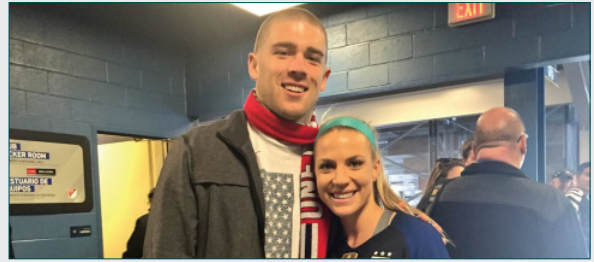

- Since 2013, ranks 6th among NFL TEs in receiving yards (3,664), behind **Rob Gronkowski** (4,516), **Greg Olsen** (4,192), **Delanie Walker** (4,156), **Jimmy Graham** (4,152) and **Travis Kelce** (3,900)
- Has produced the most receptions (321) and receiving yards (3,664) by an Eagles TE in his first five NFL seasons
- Is the first Eagles TE to post three consecutive seasons with 800+ receiving yards since **Pete Retzlaff** from 1963-65

## 2017 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (14/13, 3/2)

- Voted to his first career **Pro Bowl**. Became the first Eagles TE named to the all-star game since **Chad Lewis** in 2003
- Tied for the 2nd-most TDs (8) by an NFL TE, trailing only **Jimmy Graham** (10). His 8 TDs also tied for the 2nd-most ever by an Eagles TE, behind **Pete Retzlaff** in 1965 (10)
- Ranked 3rd among NFL TEs in receptions (72), trailing only **Travis Kelce** (83) and **Jack Doyle** (80)
- Posted the 3rd-most receiving yards (824) by an NFL TE, behind **Rob Gronkowski** (1,084) and **Travis Kelce** (1,038)
- Caught the game-winning TD in **Super Bowl LII** at NE (2/4/18) on an 11-yard pass from **Nick Foles** that gave the Eagles a 38-33 lead with 2:21 remaining. Finished the game with 7 receptions for 67 yards and 1 TD, becoming the first Eagle with 7+ catches in back-to-back games of the same postseason since **Duce Staley** during the 2001 playoffs

Ertz and his wife, Julie, who is a star defender on the U.S. Women's National Soccer team, got married in the 2017 offseason. They couple was also featured in *ESPN Magazine's* "The Body Issue."

## HOLIDAY SPIRIT

Ertz partners annually with Bringing Hope Home's Adopt-A-Family program during the holiday season and does all of a family's holiday shopping. He also hosts the family at a home game, where he hands out presents and gives a tour of the locker room.

## HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

Ertz graduated from Monte Vista HS (Danville, CA), where he was a first-team all-state selection as a senior after catching 56 passes for 756 yards and 14 TDs. He earned All-Northern California first-team honors from *NorCalPreps.com*, first-team All-Metro honors from the *San Francisco Chronicle*, All-East Bay honors from the *Contra Costa Times* and first-team All-East Bay Athletic League honors and was also named the 2008 *Cal-Hi Sports* North Coast Section Scholar Athlete of the Year.

Ertz also played high school basketball with Mark Appel, who was selected by the Houston Astros with the No. 1-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft and now plays in the Phillies organization. Their basketball team went 32-4 and lost in the NorCal finals. Ertz was a center and Appel was a small forward.

## BIRDSEED

Ertz is the son of Lisa and Douglas, and has three younger brothers: Shane, Nic and Jackson. Lisa is an office manager and legal assistant, and Doug is a software salesman. Ertz also has a Bernese Mountain dog named Apollo. His father, Douglas, played football at Lehigh University from 1981-84 and his uncle, Davis, played baseball at Vermont from 1970-72.

Ertz earned his bachelor's degree in management science and engineering at Stanford.

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Registered a team-high 93 yards on 8 receptions in the 38-7 win vs. Min. (1/21/18) in the NFC Championship. His 93 receiving yards are the 3rd-most by a TE in Eagles postseason history, trailing only **Keith Jackson** on 1/5/91 vs. Washington (116) and 12/31/88 at Chicago (142)
- Posted a season-high 10 receptions for 103 yards and 1 TD in the 31-3 win vs. Chi. (11/26/17)
- Caught a TD pass in 4 consecutive games from 10/8/17-10/29/17, becoming the first Eagles TE to accomplish that feat since **Charle Young** from 12/1/74-9/21/75 (also 4)
- Recorded his third career multi-TD game after catching 2 TDs in the 28-23 win at Car. (10/12/17)

### 2016 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (14/12)

- Led the Eagles with a career-high 78 receptions for 816 yards and 4 TDs. His 78 catches were the 2nd-most ever by an Eagles TE (**Keith Jackson** - 81 in 1988) and ranked 5th among NFL TEs that season, behind **Dennis Pitta** (86), **Travis Kelce** (85), **Kyle Rudolph** (83), and **Greg Olsen** (80)
- Ranked 1st among NFL TEs with 5.57 receptions per game, the 3rd-highest mark by any player in team history, trailing only **Brian Westbrook** in 2007 (6.00) and 2004 (5.62)
- Grabbed 13 receptions for 139 yards and tied a career high with 2 TDs from **Carson Wentz** vs. Dal. (1/1/17)

### 2015 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (15/7)

- Set a career high with 853 yards on 75 receptions, finishing 2nd on the team in both categories

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Recorded 30 receptions over the last three games of the season, setting an Eagles record for the most catches over a three-game span
- Posted 450 receiving yards in the final four games of the 2015 season, joining **Jimmy Graham** as the only NFL TEs with at least 450 yards over a four-game span since 2013
- Became the first Eagles TE since **Brent Celek** in 2009 to register back-to-back 100+ yard games after tallying a career-high 152 yards at NYG (1/3/16)
- Caught 13 passes for 122 yards vs. Was. (12/26/15). Became just the fourth NFL TE since 1960 with multiple games with 13+ catches and 100+ yards, joining **Jason Witten** (4), **Kellen Winslow Sr.** (3) and **Tony Gonzalez** (3)

### 2014 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/5)

- Set a franchise record with 15 receptions and posted his first-career 100+ yard game (115) at Was. (12/20/14)
- Since 1950, only two NFL TEs have posted 15+ receptions in a single game: Ertz (15 - 12/20/14 at Was.) and **Jason Witten** (18 - 10/28/12 vs. NYG)

### 2013 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/3, 1/0)

- Hauled in a 3-yard TD pass from **Nick Foles** to put the team up, 24-23, in the fourth quarter of the NFC Wild Card playoff game vs. NO (1/4/14)

- Led the Eagles with 68 receiving yards while scoring a career-high-tying 2 TDs vs. Ari. (12/1/13). His performance marked the first multi-TD game by an Eagles TE in the regular season since **Chad Lewis** on 12/30/01 vs. NYG and the first by an Eagles rookie TE since **Keith Jackson** on 11/6/88 vs. L.A. Rams
- Recorded his first-career TD reception on a 15-yard throw from **Nick Foles** at Oak. (11/3/13)

## COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 38 games at Stanford and recorded 112 receptions for 1,434 yards and 15 TDs in three seasons
- As a junior, was a unanimous first-team All-American after leading all Stanford pass catchers and all FBS tight ends in receiving yards (898) and receptions (69), both school records at the position. Also named to the All-Pac-12 first team and garnered Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention accolades that year
