## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

### 2017 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/0, 3/0)

- Produced 14.1 yards per reception, which is the 3rd-highest mark by an Eagles rookie since 2000, behind **Hank Baskett** in 2006 (21.1) and **DeSean Jackson** in 2008 (14.7) (min. 15 receptions)
- Ranked 2nd among NFL rookie WRs in catch rate (72.7%), trailing only **JuJu Smith-Schuster** (73.4%) (min. 15 receptions)
- Averaged the 3rd-most yards per target (10.3) among NFL rookies, behind **JuJu Smith-Schuster** (11.6) and **O.J. Howard** (11.1) (min. 15 receptions)

## WALK-ON STORY

Hollins, who served four terms as a special teams captain at North Carolina, joined the Tar Heels football team as a walk-on and finished his career as one of the top receivers in school history, totaling 81 receptions for 1,667 yards (20.6 avg.) and 20 TDs. Hollins credits taking advantage of special teams opportunities for leading to his on-field success in college.

## EXOTIC ANIMALS

Hollins, whose dream job is to own a world-renowned aquarium, has been interested in exotic animals for quite some time. He is the owner of two snakes – a Ball Python and a Sunglow Boa – and has previously owned turtles. He also bred African Cichlid fish in high school.

## BIRDSEED

Hollins is the son of Karyn and Richard Hollins. Hollins prepped at Wootton HS (Rockville, MD), where he played wide receiver and on defense and also participated in basketball and lacrosse. He also spent a postgrad semester at Fork Union Military Academy (Fork Union, VA). Hollins graduated from the University of North Carolina with a degree in exercise and sport science.

## COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Came to UNC as a walk-on and finished his career as one of the top receivers in school history. Totaled 81 receptions for 1,667 yards (20.6 avg.) and 20 TDs
- Set the UNC career record for yards per reception and ranked 3rd on the school's all-time list for receiving TDs. Led the NCAA with a career-high 24.8 yards per reception (24.8 avg.) as a junior in 2015
- Garnered second-team All-ACC honors after finishing his junior season with 30 catches for a team-high 745 yards and 8 TDs
