In 2010, Johnston was drafted by the Melbourne Demons of the Australian Football League with the 52nd selection in the NAB Rookie Draft. Although he never played in a game for Melbourne, he made 6 appearances for the Casey Scorpions, a reserve squad for Melbourne which competes in the Victorian Football League.

Johnston trained at Prokick Australia in Melbourne, where he worked with founder Nathan Chapman to hone his craft in order to make the transition to American football.

Johnston landed 109 punts inside the 20 during his career, shattering the previous Ohio State record of 78 set by A.J. Trapasso (2005-08).

- Earned honorable mention All-Big Ten recognition and was a semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award after leading the Big Ten in punting average (45.1) in 2014
