CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

2018 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/16, 2/2)

- Posted his first career multi-TD game in the 24-0 playoff-clinching victory at Was. (12/30/18)
- Led the Eagles with a season-high 116 yards in the 32-30 win vs. Hou. (12/23/18), marking the 2nd-highest single-game total of his career (141 yards on 12/3/17 at Seattle). Caught an 83-yard TD pass from **Nick Foles** in the third quarter that gave the Eagles a 23-16 lead. The score was the longest receiving TD by an Eagle since **DeSean Jackson** caught a 91-yard TD from **Michael Vick** on 12/12/10 at Dallas
- With the score tied and just 2:39 remaining in the game, caught a crucial 4th-and-1 pass from **Carson Wentz** for a 12-yard gain to set up a game-winning 43-yard FG by **Jake Elliott** in the 25-22 win vs. NYG (11/25/18)
- Led the team with 91 yards on 3 catches in the 34-13 win at NYG (10/11/18), including a season-long 58-yard reception in the second quarter that set up a 10-yard TD pass from **Carson Wentz** to **Zach Ertz** on the next play

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Recorded a season-high-tying 8 receptions for 88 yards at TB (9/16/18). Became just the second player in Eagles history to post 8+ receptions in 3 straight games (including playoffs), joining **Zach Ertz** (12/20/15-1/3/16)
- Led the Eagles with a season-high 8 catches for 33 yards in the season-opening win vs. Atl. (9/7/18)

2017 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/10, 3/3)

- Enjoyed a breakout season, producing career highs in receptions (62), receiving yards (768) and receiving TDs (8)
- Tied for 8th in the NFL in receiving TDs (8), behind **DeAndre Hopkins** (13), **Davante Adams** (10), **Jimmy Graham** (10), **Antonio Brown** (9), **Alshon Jeffery** (9), **Marvin Jones Jr.** (9) and **Jarvis Landry** (9)
- Led Philadelphia with nine 20+ yard receptions, including two 50+ yard receiving TDs, which are the most by an Eagle in a single season since **Jeremy Maclin** in 2014 (3)
- Ranked 1st in the NFL in third-down yards per reception (17.5) (min. 20 receptions)

HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

Agholor attended Berkeley Prep (Tampa, FL), where he earned All-America honors as a senior running back, wide receiver, cornerback and safety. In his career, Agholor notched 4,732 rushing yards, 921 receiving yards, 12 INTs and 8 kickoff return TDs.

As a senior, Agholor totaled 212 carries for 1,983 yards and 28 TDs and 10 receptions for 117 yards and 2 TDs. He also racked up 35 tackles and 3 INTs on defense.

As a junior, Agholor had 1,440 yards on offense, 3 INTs on defense and 323 return yards.

As a sophomore, Agholor ran for 970 yards with 15 TDs and had 14 receptions for 239 yards with 3 TDs, while totaling 31 tackles and 4 INTs on defense.

Agholor also played basketball at Berkeley, where he averaged 12.8 points, 4.8 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 2.3 steals as a senior.

BIRDSEED

Agholor, who majored in communication at USC, was born in Nigeria and moved to the United States when he was 5 years old. Agholor is the son of Felix and Caroline and has four siblings. His father played high-level soccer in Nigeria.

- Posted a career-high 9 receptions for 84 yards in **Super Bowl LII** at NE (2/4/18). Tied for the 2nd-most receptions in Eagles playoff history, trailing only **Brent Celek's** 10 catches on 1/18/09 at Arizona
- Helped set up an Eagles TD drive (1-yard rushing TD by **LeGarrette Blount**) with a 21-yard gain on an end-around in the 15-10 win vs. Atl. (1/13/18) in the Divisional Round. Marked the longest rush ever by an Eagles WR in the playoffs and the longest overall by an Eagles WR since **DeSean Jackson** on 10/17/10 vs. Atlanta (31 yards)
- Paced the Eagles with 7 receptions for a career-high 141 receiving yards and 1 TD at Sea. (12/3/17). Became the first Eagle to produce 140+ receiving yards and 1+ TD in a single game since **Jordan Matthews** on 12/20/15 vs. Ari. (159-1)
- Recorded 2 TDs in the 31-3 win vs. Chi. (11/26/17). Caught a 15-yard TD in the second quarter and also registered his first career fumble recovery TD in the fourth quarter
- Posted 4 receptions for 45 yards and 1 TD in the 34-24 win vs. Was. (10/23/17). Marked his 3rd consecutive game with a receiving TD, the longest streak of his career
- Caught a 24-yard TD in the fourth quarter and finished with 55 yards on 4 receptions in the 28-23 win at Car. (10/12/17)
- Finished with 93 receiving yards in the 34-7 win vs. Ari. (10/8/17), including a career-long 72-yard TD

- Recorded a then-career-high 6 catches for 86 yards at Was. (9/10/17), including a 58-yard TD on the opening drive

2016 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (15/14)

- Registered a season-long 40-yard TD vs. NYG (12/22/16)
- Caught a 35-yard TD in the third quarter of the Eagles' 29-10 opening day victory vs. Cle. (9/11/16)

2015 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (13/12)

- Recorded the first TD of his NFL career on a 53-yard reception that gave the Eagles a 14-7, second-quarter advantage in the 23-20 win vs. Buf. (12/13/15). His 53-yard TD was the longest TD reception by an Eagles rookie since **Hank Baskett** caught TDs of 89 and 87 yards in 2006

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Compiled 3,572 all-purpose yards and 24 career TDs and became just the 12th Trojan to notch 2,000 receiving yards
- Totaled 540 yards on 37 punt returns (14.6 avg.) and set a school record with 4 punt return TDs
- Finished 8th on the USC career receptions list (179) and 7th on the career punt return yardage list (540), becoming the only Trojan to rank among the school's career Top-8 receivers and Top-7 punt returners
- Started all 13 games as a junior in 2014 and led the team with 104 receptions, 1,313 yards and 12 TDs, which were all career highs



- Earned *Associated Press* third-team All-America and first-team All-Pac-12 honors while finishing as one of 10 semifinalists for the Biletnikoff Award (nation's top wide receiver). Also won USC's Offensive Perimeter Player of the Year Award
- His 104 receptions in 2014 rank 3rd on USC's all-time single-season list and 6th in Pac-12 Conference history
- As a sophomore in 2013, was named to the All-Pac-12 second team as a return specialist and was an honorable-mention selection as a WR. Started all 14 games and racked up 56 receptions for 918 yards and 6 TDs
- His 19.1 punt return average in 2014 was a USC single-season record and ranked 2nd nationally
