Originally selected by the Eagles in the 2nd round (35th overall) of the 2013 NFL Draft, **Zach Ertz** set the NFL single-season record for receptions (team-record 116) by a TE in 2018, breaking the previous record of 110 set by Jason Witten in 2012. The two-time Pro Bowler also caught the game-winning TD vs. New England in **Super Bowl LII**.

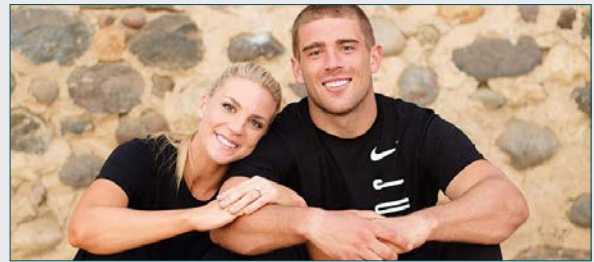

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Ranks 3rd on the Eagles' all-time receptions list (437), trailing only **Harold Carmichael** (589, 1971-83) and **Pete Retzlaff** (452, 1956-66)
- Has recorded 437 career receptions, which are the most ever by an NFL TE in their first six seasons. Also marks the most ever by an Eagles player through six seasons
- In 2018, set the single-season record for receptions by a TE (116), surpassing **Jason Witten** in 2012 (110)
- Registered a franchise-record four consecutive seasons with 70+ receptions from 2015-18, marking the longest streak by an NFL TE since **Greg Olsen** from 2013-16
- Has produced 4 career games with 13+ receptions, tied for the 2nd-most such performances in NFL history, trailing only **Wes Welker** (5, 2004-15). His 10 career games with 10+ catches are the 3rd-most ever by an NFL TE, behind **Tony Gonzalez** (15, 1997-2013) and **Jason Witten** (11, 2003-17)
- Established an Eagles single-game record with a career-high 15 receptions on 12/20/14 at Washington
- In 2018, named to his second career **Pro Bowl** after ranking 2nd in the NFL with a career-high 116 receptions (franchise and NFL TE record), trailing only **Michael Thomas** (125)



## ERTZ FAMILY FOUNDATION

Ertz and his wife, Julie, who is a star defender on the U.S. Women's National Soccer team, married during the 2017 offseason. In 2018, the couple launched the **Ertz Family Foundation**, which focuses on:

- Providing opportunities for youth to learn the value of exercise, nutrition, leadership, work ethic, accountability and team work
- Improving the quality of education through supporting teachers, students and schools
- Restoring hope and building communities for families that need it most

## HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

Ertz graduated from Monte Vista HS (Danville, CA), where he was a first-team all-state selection as a senior after catching 56 passes for 756 yards and 14 TDs. He earned All-Northern California first-team honors from *NorCalPreps.com*, first-team All-Metro honors from the *San Francisco Chronicle*, All-East Bay honors from the *Contra Costa Times* and first-team All-East Bay Athletic League honors and was also named the 2008 *Cal-Hi Sports* North Coast Section Scholar Athlete of the Year.

Ertz also played high school basketball with Mark Appel, who was selected by the Houston Astros with the No. 1-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft and now plays in the Phillies organization. Their basketball team went 32-4 and lost in the NorCal finals. Ertz was a center and Appel was a small forward.

## BIRDSEED

Ertz is the son of Lisa and Douglas, and has three younger brothers: Shane, Nic and Jackson. Lisa is an office manager and legal assistant, and Doug is a software salesman. Ertz also has a Bernese Mountain dog named Apollo. His father, Douglas, played football at Lehigh University from 1981-84 and his uncle, Davis, played baseball at Vermont from 1970-72.

Ertz earned his bachelor's degree in management science and engineering at Stanford.

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- In 2017, earned his first career **Pro Bowl** nod after leading the Eagles in receptions (72) and receiving yards (824) and tying for the 2nd-most TDs (career-high 8) by an NFL TE
- Caught the game-winning TD in **Super Bowl LII** at NE (2/4/18) on an 11-yard pass from **Nick Foles** that gave the Eagles a 38-33 lead with 2:21 remaining

## 2018 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/16, 2/2)

- Set the single-season record for receptions by an NFL TE (116), surpassing the previous mark of 110 set by **Jason Witten** in 2012. His 116 catches are also a single-season team record, surpassing **Brian Westbrook** in 2007 (90)
- Finished the season ranked 2nd in the NFL in receptions (116), trailing only **Michael Thomas** (125)
- Ranked 3rd among NFL TEs in receiving yards (1,163), behind **George Kittle** (1,377) and **Travis Kelce** (1,336). Also ranked 3rd among NFL TEs in receiving TDs
- Posted a team-high 12 receptions for 110 yards in the 32-30 win vs. Hou. (12/23/18), breaking **Jason Witten's** (110 in 2012) single-season record for receptions by a TE
- Established a new Eagles single-season record for most receptions (93) in the 28-13 win vs. Was. (12/3/18). Led the Eagles with a team-high 9 receptions for 83 yards

- Registered season highs in receptions (14), receiving yards (145) and receiving TDs (2) vs. Dal. (11/11/18). His 14 receptions and 145 receiving yards were each the 2nd-highest single-game totals of his career. Both of his TDs were game-tying scores
- Caught a 5-yard TD in the fourth quarter at Jax. (10/28/18)
- Paced the team with 9 receptions and a season-high 138 receiving yards (15.3 avg.) vs. Car. (10/21/18)
- Recorded his second consecutive game with a receiving TD in the 34-13 win at NYG (10/11/18). Hauled in a 10-yard TD pass from **Carson Wentz** that gave the Eagles a 21-6 lead in the second quarter
- Caught his first TD of the season and posted his second consecutive game with 10+ catches (10) and 100+ receiving yards (110) vs. Min. (10/7/18). - Tied with **Dallas Goedert** for the team lead with 73 receiving yards in the win vs. Ind. (9/23/18). Ertz and Goedert became the first pair of Eagles TEs to record 70+ receiving yards in the same game since **Ray Poage** (5-142) and **Pete Retzlaff** (6-118) on 12/5/65 vs. Dallas

- Recorded his franchise-record 6th-career game with 10+ receptions after leading the team in receptions (11) and receiving yards (94) at TB (9/16/18). His 6 career games with 10+ receptions ranks 1st among NFL TEs since he entered the league in 2013

- Voted to his first career **Pro Bowl**. Became the first Eagles TE named to the all-star game since **Chad Lewis** in 2003
- Tied for the 2nd-most TDs (8) by an NFL TE, trailing only **Jimmy Graham** (10). His 8 TDs also tied for the 2nd-most ever by an Eagles TE, behind **Pete Retzlaff** in 1965 (10)
- Ranked 3rd among NFL TEs in receptions (72), trailing only **Travis Kelce** (83) and **Jack Doyle** (80)
- Posted the 3rd-most receiving yards (824) by an NFL TE, behind **Rob Gronkowski** (1,084) and **Travis Kelce** (1,038)
- Caught the game-winning TD in **Super Bowl LII** at NE (2/4/18) on an 11-yard pass from **Nick Foles** that gave the Eagles a 38-33 lead with 2:21 remaining. Became the first Eagle with 7+ catches in back-to-back games of the same postseason since **Duce Staley** during the 2001 playoffs
- Registered a team-high 93 yards on 8 receptions in the 38-7 win vs. Min. (1/21/18) in the NFC Championship. His 93 receiving yards are the 3rd-most by a TE in Eagles postseason history, trailing only **Keith Jackson** on 1/5/91 vs. Washington (116) and 12/31/88 at Chicago (142)

His 78 catches were the 2nd-most ever by an Eagles TE (**Keith Jackson** - 81 in 1988) and ranked 5th among NFL TEs that season, behind **Dennis Pitta** (86), **Travis Kelce** (85), **Kyle Rudolph** (83), and **Greg Olsen** (80)
- Ranked 1st among NFL TEs with 5.57 receptions per game, the 3rd-highest mark by any player in team history, trailing only **Brian Westbrook** in 2007 (6.00) and 2004 (5.62)
- Grabbed 13 receptions for 139 yards and tied a career high with 2 TDs from **Carson Wentz** vs. Dal. (1/1/17)

### 2015 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (15/7)

- Set a career high with 853 yards on 75 receptions, finishing 2nd on the team in both categories
- Recorded 30 receptions over the last three games of the season, setting an Eagles record for the most catches over a three-game span
- Posted 450 receiving yards in the final four games of the 2015 season, joining **Jimmy Graham** as the only NFL TEs with at least 450 yards over a four-game span since 2013
- Became the first Eagles TE since **Brent Celek** in 2009 to register back-to-back 100+ yard games after tallying a career-high 152 yards at NYG (1/3/16)
- Caught 13 passes for 122 yards vs. Was. (12/26/15). Became just the fourth NFL TE since 1960 with multiple games with 13+ catches and 100+ yards, joining **Jason Witten** (4), **Kellen Winslow Sr.** (3) and **Tony Gonzalez** (3)

### 2014 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/5)

- Set a franchise record with 15 receptions and posted his first-career 100+ yard game (115) at Was. (12/20/14)
- Since 1950, only two NFL TEs have posted 15+ receptions in a single game: Ertz (15 - 12/20/14 at Was.) and **Jason Witten** (18 - 10/28/12 vs. NYG)

### 2013 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/3, 1/0)

- Hauled in a 3-yard TD pass from **Nick Foles** to put the team up, 24-23, in the fourth quarter of the NFC Wild Card playoff game vs. NO (1/4/14)
- Led the Eagles with 68 receiving yards while scoring a career-high-tying 2 TDs vs. Ari. (12/1/13). His performance marked the first multi-TD game by an Eagles TE in the regular season since **Chad Lewis** on 12/30/01 vs. NYG and the first by an Eagles rookie TE since **Keith Jackson** on 11/6/88 vs. L.A. Rams
- Recorded his first-career TD reception on a 15-yard throw from **Nick Foles** at Oak. (11/3/13)

## COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 38 games at Stanford and recorded 112 receptions for 1,434 yards and 15 TDs in three seasons
- As a junior, was a unanimous first-team All-American after leading all Stanford pass catchers and all FBS tight ends in receiving yards (898) and receptions (69), both school records at the position. Also named to the All-Pac-12 first team and Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention team
- As a sophomore, appeared in 10 games (three starts) and hauled in 27 receptions for 343 yards and 4 TDs
- Caught 16 passes for 190 yards and 5 TDs in 13 games as a redshirt freshman. His 5 TDs ranked 3rd on the team, behind **Doug Baldwin** (9) and **Coby Fleener** (7)
