Matt Pryor was originally selected by the Eagles in the 6th round (206th overall) of the 2018 NFL Draft. The California native played collegiately at TCU, where he started in 31 games (23 at guard) and earned All-Big 12 honors following his senior season in 2017.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Started in 31 games (23 at guard) during his tenure with the Horned Frogs, including an Alamo Bowl victory over Stanford to end his collegiate career
- Started every game his junior and senior seasons, winning 17 games during that span
- Named second-team All-Big 12 at the guard position as a senior, when he helped TCU rank 17th in the nation in total touchdowns (62)
- Blocked for QB **Kenny Hill**, who threw for 3,152 yards and rushed for 325 yards in 2017. Helped Hill achieve the 2nd-best completion percentage in the Big 12
