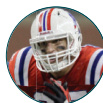

Richard Rodgers was signed by the Eagles during the 2018 offseason after spending the first four years of his career with Green Bay. Rodgers was selected by the Packers in the 3rd round (98th overall) of the 2014 NFL Draft and has registered 120 receptions for 1,166 yards and 13 TDs in 63 career regular-season games (24 starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2015, ranked 5th among NFL TEs with a career-high 8 TDs (tied for 5th-most by a TE in Packers history), trailing only **Tyler Eifert** (13), **Rob Gronkowski** (11), **Jordan Reed** (11) and **Gary Barnidge** (9)
- Set a single-game, regular-season record for receiving yards by a Packers TE (146) at Det. (12/3/15), highlighted by his game-winning 61-yard TD on a Hail Mary pass from **Aaron Rodgers** on the final play of the game
- The Hail Mary was the 2nd-longest come-from-behind, game-ending TD from scrimmage in the fourth quarter in NFL history, behind Lions QB **Earl Morrall**'s 65-yard TD pass to TE **Jim Gibbons** on 12/4/60

2017 - GREEN BAY PACKERS (15/1)

- Caught 12 passes for 160 yards (13.3 avg.) and 1 TD
- Posted a season-high 4 receptions for a season-best 77 yards (19.3 avg.) and 1 TD at Car. (12/17/17). His 19.3 yards per reception were a career high. Became the first Green Bay TE with 75+ yards in a game on 4-or-fewer receptions since **Jermichael Finley** on 10/13/13 at Baltimore

2016 - GREEN BAY PACKERS (16/6, 3/0)

- Produced 30 catches for 271 yards and 2 TDs in the regular season and added a 34-yard receiving TD in the playoffs

2015 - GREEN BAY PACKERS (16/12, 2/2)

- Ranked 5th among NFL TEs with a career-high 8 TDs (tied for 5th-most by a TE in Packers history), trailing only **Tyler Eifert** (13), **Rob Gronkowski** (11), **Jordan Reed** (11) and **Gary Barnidge** (9)
- Became just the fourth TE in team history to record 55+ receptions (58) in a single season, joining **Paul Coffman**, **Jermichael Finley** and **Jackie Harris**
- Was one of only four NFL TEs in 2015 with 55+ receptions (58), 500+ receiving yards (510) and 8+ receiving TDs (8), joining **Rob Gronkowski**, **Jordan Reed** and **Gary Barnidge**
- Registered postseason career highs in receptions (7) and receiving yards (56) during the Packers' playoff run
- Set a single-game, regular-season record for receiving yards by a Packers TE (146) at Det. (12/3/15), highlighted by his game-winning 61-yard TD on a Hail Mary pass from **Aaron Rodgers** on the final play of the game
- The Hail Mary was the 2nd-longest come-from-behind, game-ending TD from scrimmage in the fourth quarter in NFL history, behind Lions QB **Earl Morrall**'s 65-yard TD pass to TE **Jim Gibbons** on 12/4/60

FAMILY TIES

Rodgers' father, Richard Sr., is the assistant defensive backs/safeties coach for the Carolina Panthers. Richard Sr. was a two-time All-Pacific-10 selection as a defensive back at California, where he was prominently involved in "The Play" against Stanford in 1982, making the last of five laterals. Richard Sr. went on to play three seasons (1987-88, 1992) in the Arena Football League.

Rodgers' uncle, Gill Byrd, was most recently the cornerbacks coach for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. His cousin, Jairus Byrd, played safety for the Buffalo Bills from 2009-13 and the New Orleans Saints from 2014-16.

Rodgers' grandfather, Clyde Mashore, played professional baseball for five seasons (1969-73), and his uncle, Damon Mashore, played three seasons in the majors (1996-98).

BIRDSEED

Rodgers attended St. John's (MA) High School, where he was named a Prep Star All-American after leading all Massachusetts Division C-1 players in receiving, sacks and scoring as a senior in 2010. Rodgers caught 65 passes for 1,064 yards (16.4 avg.) and 16 TDs for a 12-1 squad that won the state's Division IA Conference with a 5-0 league mark. At defensive end, he registered 35 tackles, 8.0 sacks, 1 INT, 4 FFs and 2 FRs. Rodgers was also named the Defensive MVP of the Division IA Conference as a junior in 2009 after posting 42 tackles, 3.0 sacks and 4 INTs, including one he returned 75 yards for a TD. Rodgers, who resides in Santa Rosa, CA, majored in American Studies at California.
