Signed by Philadelphia as an undrafted free agent in 2017, **Corey Clement** (pronounced CLEM-int) became the first undrafted Eagle to register 1,200+ all-purpose yards (1,294) in their first two NFL seasons since **Derrick Witherspoon** from 1995-96 (1,737). Clement caught a team-high 100 receiving yards in **Super Bowl LII** and fielded the snap on the "Philly Special," one of the most memorable trick plays in league history.

Became just the fourth rookie in NFL history with 100+ receiving yards in the Super Bowl, joining **Chris Matthews** (109 - XLIX with Seattle), **Torry Holt** (109 - XXXIV with St. Louis) and **Cris Collinsworth** (107 - XVI with Cincinnati)
- Fielded the snap on one of the most memorable trick plays in NFL history in **Super Bowl LII**, known as the "Philly Special," when **Nick Foles** caught a TD from **Trey Burton** on fourth down

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

2018 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (11/0, 0/0)

- Totaled career highs in receptions (22), receiving yards (192) and scrimmage yards (451). Also led the team in kickoff return yards (333) and kickoff return average (25.6)
- Registered a career-long 32-yard run in the second quarter of the 25-22 win vs. NYG (11/25/18). Marked the 2nd-longest play from scrimmage of his career (55-yard reception on 2/4/18 vs. New England in **Super Bowl LII**)
- Recorded career highs in kickoff returns (4) and kickoff return yards (114) and registered the longest kickoff return (48 yards) of his career at NO (11/18/18)
- Produced career highs in rush attempts (16) and rushing yards (56) in the 20-16 win vs. Ind. (9/23/18)
- Rushed for a game-tying (7-7), 15-yard TD in the second quarter at TB (9/16/18). The score tied for the longest rushing TD of his career (also 9/24/17 vs. N.Y. Giants)

BIRDSEED

Clement prepped at Glassboro HS (Glassboro, NJ), where he was coached by Mark Maccarone. He was selected to the Semper Fidelis All-American Bowl after finishing his high school career with an outstanding 6,245 rushing yards, 34 rushing TDs and 90 total TDs. Clement, who set the New Jersey state record with 479 yards against Gloucester City, earned first-team all-state honors after rushing for 2,323 yards and 33 TDs while also recording 47 tackles and 8.0 sacks as a senior. He also ran for 2,510 yards and 36 total TDs as a junior and tallied 1,205 rushing yards and 15 TDs as a sophomore.

Clement is the son of Latanya and Steve Clement. He majored in life sciences communication at the University of Wisconsin and interned at Merrill Lynch during the summer of 2016.

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Registered a career-long 55-yard reception in **Super Bowl LII**. Marked the longest catch by a RB in the Super Bowl since **Kenny King's** 80-yard TD vs. Philadelphia with Oakland in Super Bowl XV
- Fielded the snap on one of the most memorable trick plays in NFL history in **Super Bowl LII**, known as the "Philly Special," when **Nick Foles** caught a TD from **Trey Burton**
- Totaled a career-high-tying 5 catches in the Divisional Playoff win vs. Atl. (1/13/18). Became the first Eagles rookie with 5+ catches in a playoff game since **Jeremy Maclin** (7) on 1/9/10 at Dallas
- His 6 TDs (team-high 4 rushing TDs) in the regular season tied for the 4th-most ever by an Eagles rookie RB, behind **Mel Bleeker** in 1944 (8), **Don Johnson** in 1953 (7) and **Steve Van Buren** in 1944 (7)
- Tacked on the first 2-point conversion of his career after scoring his 6th TD of the season (4th rushing TD) on the opening drive of the second half at Dal. (11/19/17)
- Produced a career-high 3 TDs (2 rushing, 1 receiving) in the 51-23 win vs. Den. (11/5/17). Became the first Eagle with 2+ rushing TDs and 1+ receiving TD in a game since **Brian Westbrook** on 11/27/08 vs. Arizona and the first Eagles rookie since **Don Johnson** on 11/15/53 at Baltimore
- Made an acrobatic catch for his first career receiving TD on a 9-yard pass from **Carson Wentz** vs. Was. (10/23/17)

- Registered his first career TD on a 15-yard run that tied the game, 21-21, in the win vs. NYG (9/24/17)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- A member of the winningest senior class in Wisconsin history (41-13, .759). Rushed for 3,092 yards and 36 TDs on 576 attempts (5.4 avg.) while adding 29 catches for 279 yards and 2 TDs in 43 career games (15 starts)
- Earned first-team All-Big Ten honors after posting career highs with 314 carries for 1,375 yards (4.3 avg.) and 15 TDs in 13 games (all starts) as a senior in 2016
- Finished his senior season with eight 100+ yard rushing games, including five straight to end the year. Rushed for a career-high-tying 164 yards vs. Ohio State (10/15/16) and vs. Penn State (12/3/16)
- Played in all 14 games as a sophomore in 2014, rushing 147 times for 949 yards (6.5 avg.) and 9 TDs. Combined with **Melvin Gordon** (2,587) to set the single-season FBS record for rushing yards by teammates at 3,536 yards. Registered a career-high 164 yards vs. Illinois (11/11/14)
