One of the top free agent signings of the 2017 offseason, **Alshon Jeffery** ranks 6th among NFL WRs in receiving TDs (15) and T-3rd in red zone TDs (13) since joining the Eagles. In 2018, the veteran wideout posted a career-high catch rate (70.7%) as well as his most receptions (65) and receiving yards (843) since 2014, despite missing the first 3 games of the season.

- Caught a 2-yard TD pass from **Nick Foles** in the 24-0 playoff-clinching victory at Was. (12/30/18). The score capped a 19-play, 87-yard drive that lasted 11:49, marking the Eagles' longest drive by plays since 9/7/97 vs. Green Bay (also 19 plays) (longest TD drive by NFL team since 2014)
- Posted 82 yards on 3 receptions (27.3 avg.) in the 32-30 win vs. Hou. (12/23/18), including a season-long 52-yard reception in the third quarter. Became the first Eagle to record 50+ yard receptions in back-to-back games since **Jeremy Maclin** from 10/26/14-11/2/14
- Recorded 8 receptions for a season-high 160 yards (20.0 avg.) in the 30-23 win at LAR (12/16/18). His 160 receiving yards are his most as an Eagle and the 3rd-most of his NFL career, behind 12/1/13 at Minnesota with Chicago (249 yards) and 10/6/13 vs. New Orleans with Chicago (218 yards)
- Caught 7 passes for 88 yards (12.6 avg.) vs. Car. (10/21/18), including an 11-yard TD
- Totaled a season-high-tying 8 catches for 73 yards and 2 TDs in the 34-13 win at NYG (10/11/18). Marked his 5th career multi-TD game and first since the 2017 NFC Championship
- Produced his 14th career 100+ yard game (first as an Eagle) after logging 8 receptions for 105 yards and 1 TD in his season debut at Ten. (9/30/18)

As a senior, he caught 35 passes for 740 yards and 14 TDs, averaged 65 yards on kickoff returns and 35 yards on punt returns with 3 TDs and totaled 50 tackles on defense. Jeffery, who was also a standout basketball player, helped lead Calhoun County to four state titles.

2017 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (16/16, 3/3)

- Led the Eagles with 219 receiving yards and 3 TDs during the team's **Super Bowl LII**-winning playoff run. Both totals marked franchise records for receiving yards and receiving TDs in a single postseason
- Caught 3 passes for 73 yards (24.3 avg.) in **Super Bowl LII** at NE (2/4/18), including a 34-yard TD from QB **Nick Foles** that gave the Eagles a 9-3 lead in the first quarter. Became the first Eagle since **Fred Barnett** in 1992 to record multiple 30+ yard TD catches in the same postseason
- Recorded 5 receptions for 85 yards and 2 TDs (53 and 5 yards) in the NFC Championship vs. Min. (1/21/18)
- Led the Eagles offense with 61 receiving yards in the Divisional Playoff vs. Atl. (1/13/18)
- Finished with a team-high 9 receiving TDs, which marks the 2nd-highest total of his career. His 9 receiving TDs also tied for the 4th-most in the NFL, trailing only **DeAndre Hopkins** (13), **Davante Adams** (10) and **Jimmy Graham** (10)
- Converted the most 2-point conversions (3, all receiving) in a single season since **Reggie Bush** in 2007 (also 3)

2016 - CHICAGO BEARS (12/12)

- Led the Bears in yards per reception (15.8) and receiving yards per game (68.4) (min. 20 receptions)

2015 - CHICAGO BEARS (9/8)

- Tallied 54 catches for a team-high 807 yards (14.9) and 4 TDs, despite appearing in just 9 games
- Registered 4 games with 100+ receiving yards (147 - 10/18/15 at Det.; 116 - 11/1/15 vs. Min.; 151 - 11/9/15 at SD; 107 - 12/13/15 vs. Was.). His 3 consecutive games with 100+ receiving yards tied for Chicago's franchise record

2014 - CHICAGO BEARS (16/16)

- Recorded his second consecutive 1,000+ yard receiving campaign after leading the Bears with 1,133 yards and a career-high 10 TDs on 85 receptions (13.3 avg.)
- Caught TDs in 6 straight games from 11/16-12/14/14. Became just the third player in franchise history to accomplish the feat

2013 - CHICAGO BEARS (16/14)

- Earned his first trip to the **Pro Bowl** and was named **PFWA's Most Improved Player** after registering career highs in receptions (89) and receiving yards (1,421) in 2013
- Became the 8th player in NFL history to record multiple 200+ yard receiving performances in a single season, posting 218 yards vs. NO (10/6/13) and 249 yards at Min. (12/1/13)
- Notched a career-high 12 catches at Min. (12/1/13)
