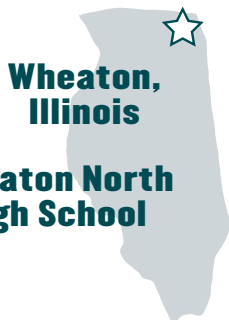

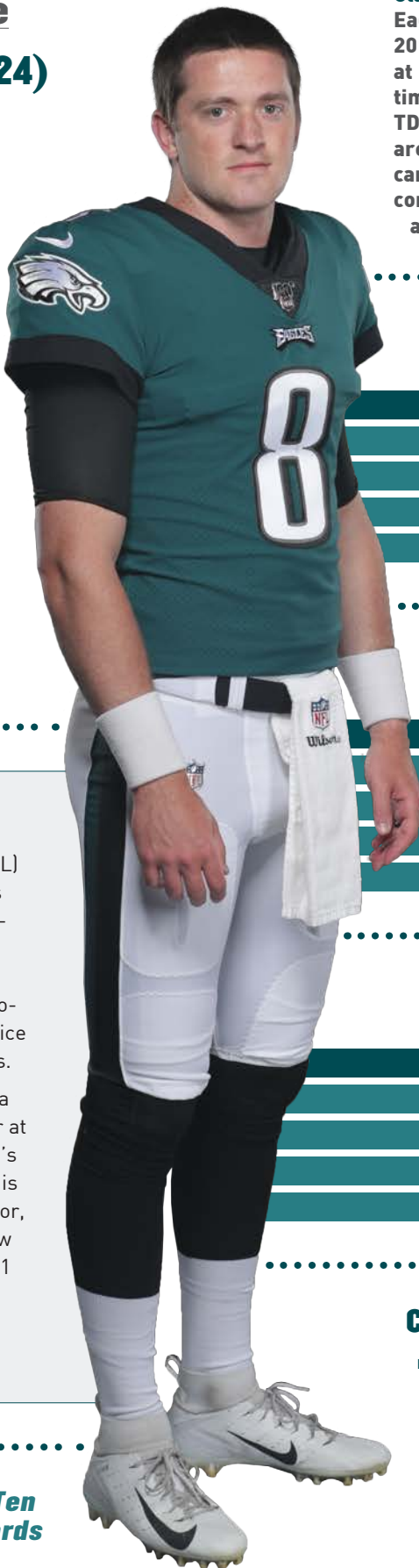

Clayton Thorson was originally selected by the Eagles in the 5th round (167th overall) of the 2019 NFL Draft. Thorson played collegiately at Northwestern, where he is the school's all-time leader in passing yards (10,731), passing TDs (61) and completions (991). The Chicago-area native also owns the Big Ten record for career starts by a QB (53) and is the only QB in conference history to pass for 10,000+ yards and rush for 20+ TDs.

BIRDSEED

Thorson prepped at Wheaton North (IL) High School, where he was ranked as a four-star recruit and the No. 6 dual-threat quarterback in the country by Rivals.com. Thorson was a four-time Tom Lemming All-Area Team and two-time All-Conference selection and twice led his team to the state quarterfinals.

Clayton is the son of Chad and Shauna Thorson. His father played linebacker at Wheaton College (also where Clayton's two older brothers played), where he is a member of the school's Hall of Honor, and signed pro contracts with the New York Giants, Philadelphia Eagles (1991 offseason) and Indianapolis Colts.

- Earned All-Big Ten honorable mention accolades after throwing for 3,183 yards and 17 TDs and rushing for 9 TDs in 14 starts as a senior in 2018
- Started all 13 games as a junior in 2017 and earned third-team All-Big Ten honors. Ranked 3rd in the Big Ten with 218.8 passing yards per game and ranked 19th in the nation with a conference-leading 21.5 completions per game
- Received Honorable Mention All-Big Ten honors following his sophomore season in 2016. Set a new Northwestern single-season record with a career-high 22 TD passes
- Took over starting QB duties in his first season as a redshirt freshman in 2015. Became the first QB in Wildcats history to lead the team to 10+ wins in their first season
