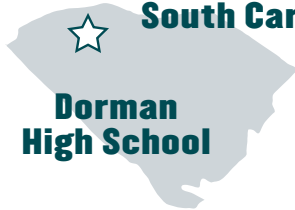

- Totaled 135 receptions for 2,219 yards (16.4 avg.) and 28 TDs in 33 games at Stanford. Finished with the 2nd-most receiving TDs in school history
- As a junior in 2018, garnered All-Pac-12 honors after leading the conference in receiving TDs (14) and ranking 3rd in receiving yards (1,059)

BIRDSEED

Arcega-Whiteside majored in international relations while at Stanford and interned at the office of Condoleezza Rice. He delivered mail, screened calls and responded to emails on behalf of Rice throughout his internship.

Arcega-Whiteside was born in Zaragoza, Spain, and moved to South Carolina at age 6. He learned English as a third language and has lived in several countries, including Spain, Portugal and Italy. He is also the son of Joaquin Arcega and Valorie Whiteside, who both played basketball professionally overseas.

Arcega-Whiteside prepped at Dorman (SC) High School, where he was the school's career leader in receptions (207), receiving yards (3,779) and TDs (38), while averaging 18.2 yards per catch as a three-year varsity starter. He also lettered in basketball and track and field.

- Led the team with 63 receptions and his 1,059 receiving yards ranked 5th in school single-season history. His 14 TDs also tied for 3rd-most in the nation
- Notched a team-high 48 receptions for 781 yards and 9 TDs in 2017, earning All-Pac-12 honorable mention
- Saw action in 12 games in 2016, recording 24 receptions for 379 yards and a team-high 5 TDs
