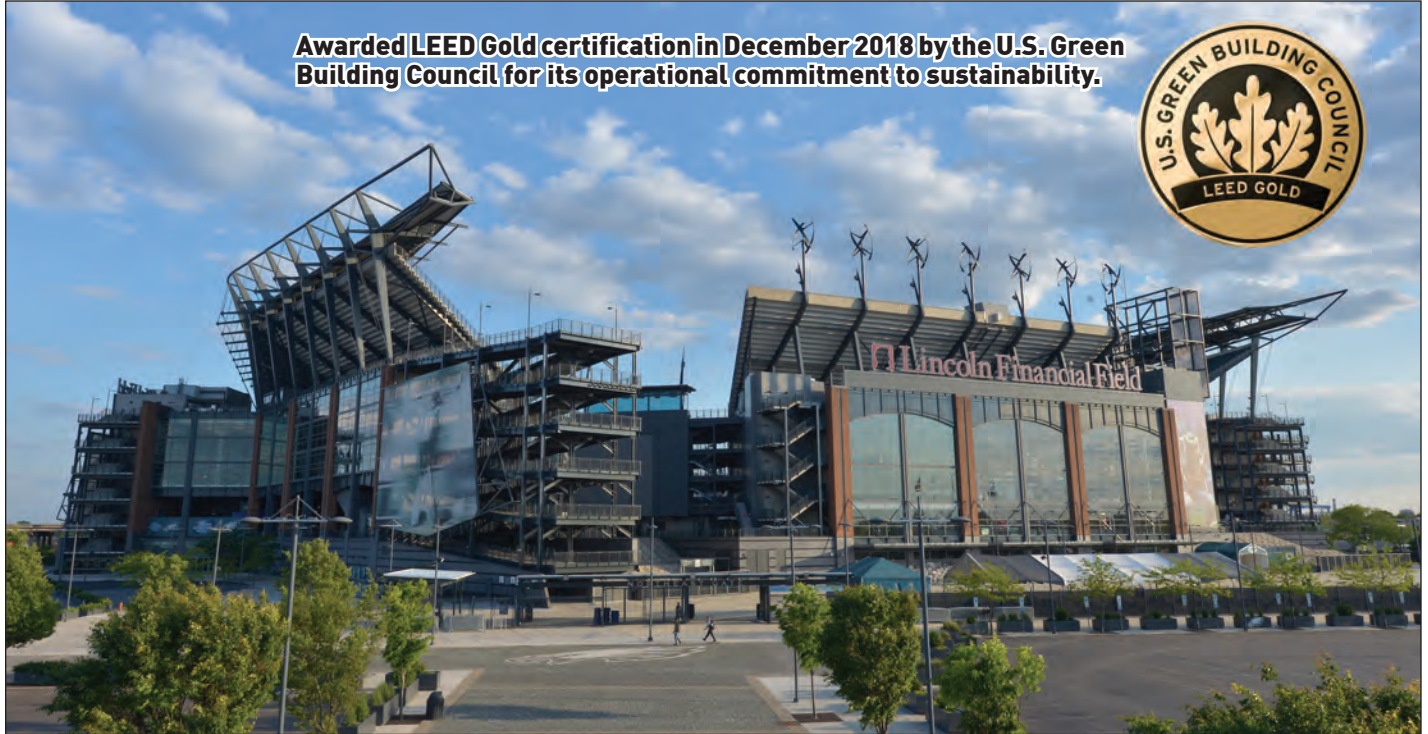


LINCOLN FINANCIAL FIELD
