Andre Dillard was selected by the Eagles with the 22nd-overall pick of the 2019 NFL Draft. Dillard played collegiately at Washington State, where he earned All-America and first-team All-Pac-12 honors as a senior in 2018. He played in 42 career games, starting the final 39 at left tackle for the Cougars.

- Started all 13 games at LT as a junior in 2017 and was named All-Pac-12 honorable mention
- Received second-team All-Pac-12 recognition from Pro Football Focus after starting all 13 games at LT during his sophomore year in 2016
