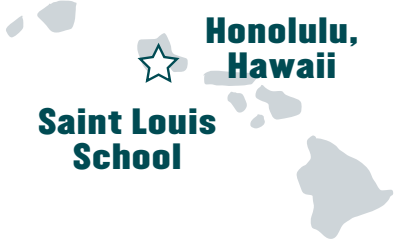

A 2019 undrafted free agent, **Nate Herbig** became one of just two UDFA's to make Philadelphia's 53-man roster out of training camp. Herbig played in 33 games during his collegiate career at Stanford, earning All-Pac-12 honors (second team) as a junior in 2018 and as a sophomore in 2017 (first team). In 2016, he became the first true freshman to start on the offensive line since 2012, and just the second true freshman to do so since 2000.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- As a junior in 2018, played in 7 games (all starts), opening 6 contests at RG and 1 at RT. Earned second-team All-Pac-12 honors and was named preseason first team All-America by the *Associated Press*. Was also named to the Outland Trophy watch list
- Played in 13 games as a sophomore in 2017 and earned first-team All-Pac-12 honors
- In 2016, became the first true freshman to start on the offensive line since 2012, and just the second true freshman to do so since 2000
