Jordan Howard was acquired by the Eagles in a trade with the Bears during the 2019 offseason. The 25-year-old Pro Bowler was originally a 5th-round draft choice (150th overall) by Chicago in 2016 and is one of only four NFL RBs with 3,500+ rushing yards (3,895) since 2016, joining Ezekiel Elliott (5,038), Todd Gurley (4,083) and Mark Ingram (3,649). Howard and Gurley were the only NFL RBs to record 9+ rushing TDs in both the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

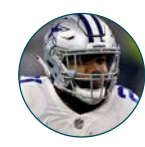

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2017, became the first Bear to rush for 1,000+ yards in each of his first two seasons. Also became the fastest Bear to reach 2,000+ career rushing yards (24 games), doing so in fewer games than **Walter Payton** (26) and **Gale Sayers** (28)
- Earned his first career **Pro Bowl** nod and was named to the PFWA **All-Rookie Team** in 2016. Became the first Bears rookie running back to be voted to the Pro Bowl since **Gale Sayers** in 1965
- Finished the 2016 season with the 2nd-most rushing yards (career-high 1,313) in the NFL, trailing only **Ezekiel Elliott** (1,631). Marked the first time since the 1970 merger that two rookies finished in the Top 2 in the NFL in rushing yardage

NOTES TO KNOW

- Has registered 525 rushing yards and 6 rushing TDs in 2019. Became the fourth Eagles RB since 1950 to record 500+ rushing yards and 6+ rushing TDs through 9 games, joining **LeSean McCoy** in 2011 (906-10), **Ricky Watters** in 1996 (898-8) and **Wilbert Montgomery** in 1982 (515-7).
- Ranks 3rd in the NFL in rushing yards (3,895) since 2016, trailing **Ezekiel Elliott** (5,038) and **Todd Gurley** (4,083). Joined Elliott as the only NFL RBs to record 900+ rushing yards in each of the last three seasons (2016-18)
- Has registered the 2nd-most rushes of 10+ yards (110) in the NFL since 2016, behind **Ezekiel Elliott** (137)
- Ranks 4th in rushing TDs (24) in the NFL since 2017, trailing only **Todd Gurley** (38), **Derrick Henry** (28) and **Mark Ingram** (27). Howard and Gurley were the only NFL RBs with 9+ rushing TDs in 2017 and 2018

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

2019 - PHILADELPHIA EAGLES (9/4)

- Rushed 19 times for 82 yards (4.3 avg.) vs. Chi. (11/3/19), his former team, including a 13-yard rushing TD in the third quarter that lifted the Eagles to a 19-0 lead
- Contributed a team-leading 96 rushing yards, including a 3-yard TD in the fourth quarter, on 23 carries (4.2 avg.) in the win at Buf. (10/27/19). Howard and **Miles Sanders** became the first Eagles RB duo to each rush for 70+ yards and 1+ TD in a road game since **Leroy Keyes** and **Tom Woodeshick** on 11/9/69 at Washington. The Eagles' 218 rushing yards marked their highest single-game total during the **Doug Pederson** era (since 2016)



BIRDSEED

Howard played running back at Gardendale (AL) High School, where he collected 2,876 yards on 380 attempts in his two varsity seasons, including 1,388 yards and 21 TDs in 10 games as a senior. Howard was named the *Birmingham News North/East* Player of the Year and also received 2011 Honorable Mention All-State accolades.

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Paced the Eagles' rushing attack with 62 yards and 1 TD on 13 carries (4.8 avg.) in the win vs. NYJ (10/6/19). Became the first Eagles RB with 5+ offensive TDs in a 3-game span since **LeSean McCoy** from 12/1/11-12/18/11 (also 5 TDs). Is the first Eagle to rush for a TD in 3 straight games since **Ryan Mathews** from 10/30/16-11/13/16
- Led the Eagles with a season-high 87 rushing yards and combined for a career-high-tying 3 offensive TDs (2 rushing, 1 receiving) in the win at GB (9/26/19). Became just the third Eagles RB with 3 offensive TDs in a single game since 2010, joining **Corey Clement** (11/5/17 vs. Den.) and **LeSean McCoy** (12/18/11 vs. NYJ and 9/19/10 at Det.). Only two visiting players in NFL history have recorded 2+ rushing TDs and 1+ receiving TD against the Packers at Lambeau Field: Howard and **Willie Galimore** (9/28/58 with Chicago)
- Capped a 9-play, 75-yard scoring drive with a 1-yard TD plunge to help the Eagles reclaim the lead, 10-7, in the first quarter vs. Det. (9/22/19). Marked his first TD as an Eagle and first overall since a multi-TD performance (2 rushing TDs) on 12/30/18 at Minnesota with Chicago

2018 - CHICAGO BEARS (16/15, 1/1)

- Led the Bears with 935 rushing yards and posted a career-high-tying 9 rushing TDs for the second straight season
- Totaled 88 carries for 399 yards (4.53 avg.) and 4 TDs over the last 5 games of the regular season, including two 100+ yard performances. Rushed for 101 yards vs. LAR (12/9/18) and 109 yards at Min. (12/30/18)

2017 - CHICAGO BEARS (16/16)

- Ranked 6th in the NFL with 1,122 rushing yards, behind **Kareem Hunt** (1,327), **Todd Gurley** (1,305), **Le'Veon Bell** (1,291), **LeSean McCoy** (1,138) and **Mark Ingram** (1,124)
- Became the first Bear to rush for 1,000+ yards in each of his first two seasons. Also became the fastest Bear to reach 2,000+ career rushing yards (24 games)
- Tied with **Le'Veon Bell** and **Leonard Fournette** for the 3rd-most rushing TDs (career-high 9) in the NFL, trailing only **Todd Gurley** (13) and **Mark Ingram** (12)

2016 - CHICAGO BEARS (15/13)

- Earned his first career **Pro Bowl** nod and was named to the PFWA **All-Rookie Team**. Became the first Bears rookie RB to be voted to the Pro Bowl since **Gale Sayers** in 1965
- Finished with the 2nd-most rushing yards (career-high 1,313) in the NFL, behind **Ezekiel Elliott** (1,631). Marked the first time since the 1970 merger that two rookies finished in the Top 2 in the NFL in rushing yardage
- Ranked 4th in the NFL with a 5.2 rushing average (led the NFC), behind **Mike Gillislee** (5.7), **Bilal Powell** (5.5) and **LeSean McCoy** (5.4) (min. 100 attempts)
- Named **NFC Offensive Rookie of the Month** for December/January after rushing for 547 yards (5.3 avg.) and 4 TDs in 5 games. Ranked 2nd in the NFL in rushing yards per game (109.4) in that span (including 3 games with 100+ yards), trailing only **Le'Veon Bell** (142.3)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 32 career games over three seasons with UAB (2013-14) and Indiana (2015), compiling 3,681 rushing yards on 647 attempts (5.7 avg.) and 24 rushing TDs. Earned first-team All-Big Ten (2015), All-CUSA (2014) and CUSA All-Freshman Team (2013) honors
- As a junior at Indiana in 2015, ranked 3rd in the Big Ten with 1,213 rushing yards and added 9 TDs
- Set UAB's single-season rushing yardage record (1,587) during the program's final season in 2014. Also averaged 5.2 yards per attempt and produced 13 rushing TDs
