A three-time Pro Bowler who caught the game-winning TD in Super Bowl LII, Zach Ertz has produced more receptions (525) than any other NFL TE in their first seven seasons. He also ranks 2nd on the Eagles' all-time receptions list, trailing only Pro Football Hall of Famer Harold Carmichael (589, 1971-83). In 2018, Ertz set the NFL single-season record for receptions by a TE with 116.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Is a three-time **Pro Bowl** honoree (2018, 2019, 2020)
- Set the NFL single-season record for receptions by a TE (116, most by any player in Eagles history) in 2018, surpassing **Jason Witten** in 2012 (110). His career-high 116 receptions ranked 2nd overall in the NFL, trailing only **Michael Thomas** (125)
- Caught the game-winning TD in **Super Bowl LII** at NE (2/4/18) on an 11-yard pass from **Nick Foles** that gave the Eagles a 38-33 lead with 2:21 remaining in regulation
- Established a franchise single-game record with 15 receptions on 12/20/14 at Washington

NOTES TO KNOW

- Ranks 2nd on the Eagles' all-time receptions list (525), behind Pro Football Hall of Famer **Harold Carmichael** (589, 1971-83)
- Is one of five players in team history to record 800+ receiving yards and 6+ receiving TDs in 3 consecutive seasons (2017-19), joining **Mike Quick** (4, 1983-86), **Harold Carmichael** (4, 1978-81), **Tommy McDonald** (4, 1959-62) and **Pete Pihos** (3, 1953-55)
- Is tied with **Michael Thomas** for the 2nd-most red zone receiving TDs (20) in the NFL since 2017, trailing only **Davante Adams** (22)
- Has totaled 11 career games with 10+ receptions, which is tied for the 2nd-most by a TE in NFL history, behind Pro Football Hall of Famer **Tony Gonzalez** (15, 1997-2013). Also ranks T-3rd in NFL history in 13+ catch performances (4), trailing only **Antonio Brown** (5, 2010-19) and **Wes Welker** (5, 2004-15)



ERTZ FAMILY FOUNDATION

Ertz and his wife, Julie, who is a star defender on the U.S. Women's National Soccer team, married during the 2017 offseason. In 2018, the couple launched the **Ertz Family Foundation**, which focuses on:

- Providing opportunities for youth to learn the value of exercise, nutrition, leadership, work ethic, accountability and team work
- Improving the quality of education through supporting teachers, students and schools
- Restoring hope and building communities for families that need it most

HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT

Ertz graduated from Monte Vista (CA) High School, where he was a first-team all-state selection as a senior after catching 56 passes for 756 yards and 14 TDs. He earned All-Northern California first-team honors from NorCalPreps.com, first-team All-Metro honors from the *San Francisco Chronicle*, All-East Bay honors from the *Contra Costa Times* and first-team All-East Bay Athletic League honors. Ertz was also named the 2008 Cal-Hi Sports North Coast Section Scholar Athlete of the Year.

Ertz also played high school basketball at Monte Vista. Their basketball team went 32-4 and lost in the NorCal finals.

Ertz is the son of Lisa and Douglas, and has three younger brothers: Shane, Nic and Jackson. Lisa is an office manager and legal assistant and Doug is a software salesman. Ertz has a Bernese Mountain dog named Apollo. His father, Douglas, played football at Lehigh University from 1981-84 and his uncle, Davis, played baseball at Vermont from 1970-72.

Ertz earned his bachelor's degree in management science and engineering at Stanford.

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

2019 - PHILADELPHIA (15/15, 1/1)

- Selected to the **Pro Bowl** for the third time in his career after ranking 3rd among NFL TEs in receptions (88), 4th in receiving yards (916) and T-4th in receiving TDs (6). His 88 catches tied for the 3rd-most in Eagles single-season history, trailing only himself in 2018 (116) and **Brian Westbrook** in 2007 (90)
- Registered a team-high 9 receptions for 91 yards and 2 TDs (caught game-tying and game-winning TD passes from **Carson Wentz**) in the 23-17 overtime win vs. NYG (12/9/19). Became the first TE in NFL history to catch a TD pass in both the fourth quarter and overtime in the same game
- Totaled 12 receptions for 91 yards and 1 TD vs. Sea. (11/24/19). Became the second player in team history to reach 500 career catches, joining Pro Football Hall of Famer **Harold Carmichael** (589, 1971-83). Also became the 2nd-fastest TE in NFL history to reach 500 receptions (102 games), behind Pro Football Hall of Famer **Kellen Winslow Sr.** (101, 1979-87)

2018 - PHILADELPHIA (16/16, 2/2)

- Voted to his second career **Pro Bowl** after setting the NFL single-season record for receptions by a TE (116, most by any player in Eagles history), surpassing **Jason Witten** in 2012 (110)
- Finished the regular season with the 2nd-most receptions in the NFL, trailing only **Michael Thomas** (125) in that category
- Ranked 3rd among NFL TEs in receiving yards (1,163), behind **George Kittle** (1,377) and **Travis Kelce** (1,336). Also joined **Eric Ebron** (13) and Kelce (10) as the only TEs with 8+ receiving TDs
- Broke **Jason Witten's** single-season record for receptions by a TE (110 in 2012) following a team-high 12-catch, 110-yard performance in the 32-30 win vs. Hou. (12/23/18)

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS (Continued)

- Surpassed **Brian Westbrook** in 2007 (90) for the most catches in single-season franchise history after recording a team-high 9 receptions for 83 yards in the 28-13 win vs. Was. (12/3/18)
- Recorded 10+ receptions and 100+ receiving yards in back-to-back games on 9/30/18-10/7/18. Became the first Eagle to accomplish the feat since **Pete Pihos** from 12/4/55-12/11/55 and the first NFL TE since **Tony Gonzalez** from 12/25/04-1/2/05

2017 - PHILADELPHIA (14/13, 3/2)

- Earned his first career **Pro Bowl** nod after tying for 2nd among NFL TEs in receiving TDs (8) and ranking 3rd in both receptions (72) and receiving yards (824) during the regular season
- Caught the game-winning TD in **Super Bowl LII** at NE (2/4/18) on an 11-yard pass from **Nick Foles** that gave the Eagles a 38-33 lead with 2:21 remaining in regulation
- Registered a team-high 93 yards on 8 receptions in the 38-7 win vs. Min. (1/21/18) in the NFC Championship
- Posted receiving TDs in 4 consecutive games from 10/8/17-10/29/17, becoming the first Eagles TE to do so since **Charles Young** from 12/1/74-9/21/75 (also 4)

2016 - PHILADELPHIA (14/12)

- Led the Eagles with 78 receptions for 816 yards and 4 TDs. His 78 catches ranked 5th among NFL TEs, behind **Dennis Pitta** (86), **Travis Kelce** (85), **Kyle Rudolph** (83) and **Greg Olsen** (80). Also ranked 1st among TEs in receptions per game (5.6)

2015 - PHILADELPHIA (15/7)

- Finished with the 2nd-most receptions (75) and receiving yards (853) on the Eagles offense. Produced 30 catches over the last 3 games of the regular season, setting an Eagles record for the most receptions over a 3-game span
- Totaled 450 receiving yards in the final 4 games of the season, which ranked 1st among NFL TEs during that stretch
